CodeRED Emergency Notification System

CodeRED Emergency Notification System allows the city of Buffalo to quickly send out telephone calls, text messages, emails or other digital alerts to a targeted area.

The City entered into an agreement with Emergency Com-



munications Network for the Code Red notification system, at a total cost of \$307,400, funded through a federal grant program. (MMRS - Metropolitan Medical Response System) Buffalo has already put listed numbers for land lines in its new system, however, those who want to be contacted via cellphone or digitally must register.

To register, city residents and business owners are being urged to log on to www.city-buffalo.com, and follow the link to the "CodeRED Community Notification Enrollment" page. Those without Internet access may call 311 to supply their information over the phone. The Buffalo Fire Department plans to set up registration tables with laptops at upcoming public events. Enrollment forms can also be obtained at all Buffalo Firehouses.

Fire Commissioner Whitfield cautioned, "These types of emergency notification systems are only as good as the telephone number database supporting them. No one should automatically assume his or her phone number is included. If your phone number is not in the database, you will

not be called."



Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number, additional phone numbers can be entered as well. The

data collected will only be used for emergency notification purposes, unless you opt in for non-emergency notifications, like road closures and detours. All businesses should register, as well as all individuals who have unlisted phone numbers, who have changed their phone number or address within the past year, and those who use a cellular phone as their primary number.

There is also a digital application that smartphone users can download for free that allows the person to receive notification messages in cities throughout the country. For example, if someone in Buffalo had the app and was traveling in another state that put out an emergency message, the Buffalo phone would get the message. For those who want to use the mobile app, it's available through www.codedred-web.com.

A test phone call will be made on Thursday, August 8, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. to everyone in the city's database. Those who do not get phone call on Thursday, August 8, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. are asked to re-register for the Code RED Community Notification Enrollment.

Rocket Man

When the Journey Began

When Rocket Man touched down in Bloomsburg, PA, in September of '56, It Looked Like For Ever (invoking the title of one of his favorite novels). It was, and it wasn't. Within a year, he had lifted off again, to establish a floating but permanent base within the orbit of Western New York.

But had left his heart in Bloomsburg and on this date, Aug. 8, 54 years ago, he and the First Mate walked through the airlock to the Planet Matrimony. They've still got the receipts to prove it, less than \$100 for the whole shebang. A few said it should never happen and a few more foresaw a brief voyage, even in those times when "death to us part" was alive and well.

Even now they continue to wonder at how mismatched they still are, in so many ways.

Rocket Man came to this realization while imagining a log of memorable moments.

All the multi-venued adventures, from the trains, planes and automobiles nationwide tour when the children were 8 and 12, to the six-day rail roundtrip to Vancouver just before "The

October Surprise," these were largely of his making and inspiration.

The more intense, stationary gatherings – the week-long whole-family rental of a do-it-yourself hotel on Oneida Lake, the 45th anniversary party at Italian Village in Cheektowaga, these were mostly the First Mate's design. (Why 45th rather than 50th? She instinctively felt people would be healthier. Of those attending the 45th, nearly a third were gone by the time of the gold.)

It figures. A "rail-road brat," Rocket Man had eight addresses in seven locales before high school. First Mate, abandoned by her father as a child, had seldom passed Bloomsburg's


borders. "She was 24 before she realized she was free to leave," he would say.

Since then, she has come to love baseball and tolerate golf. He has come to love cats and tolerate Doris Day.

While they tend to hang with a wide variety of people (Rocket Man last played ball for a Negro League team in LeRoy, still has the uniform), it wasn't until last month that they attended a Bat Mitzvah, a coming-of-age ceremony for girls of the Jewish faith. There, they learned of the significance of the number "18" in the ritual. They're a bit unclear as to why, but any monetary gifts are deemed to more appropriate if the number is divisible by 18.

If that is indeed the case, then Rocket Man and First Mate are thrice blessed.

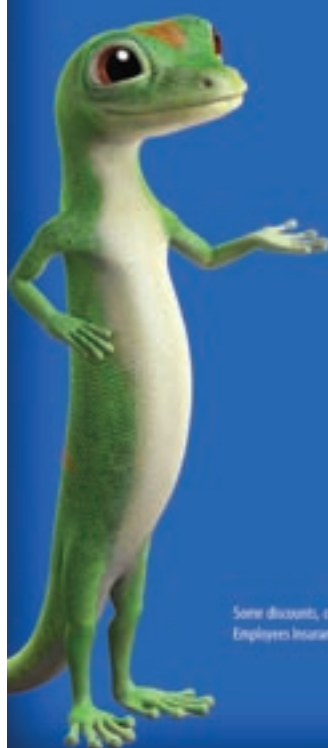
