The West Side Rowing Club of Buffalo (WSRC) is once again hosting its annual Head of the Ni-

the Western New York and Canada area rowing the 2.5 mile course on the Black Rock Canal in 35 different events.

Originally two events, the Wright Regatta is in its sixth year, showcasing the only boathouse built to feature Frank Lloyd Wright's prized one and only boathouse design. The Head of the Niagara is also an annual event that brings teams in from all over the eastern part of the country, as well as Canadian teams.

A head race is a timetrial competition. Boats race against the clock and crews completing the course in the shortest time (for their specific age/ability/boat class) win a traditional West Side Rowing Club mug.

"Six Dance Lessons"

"You have to get used to my sense of humor," hooferhelper Michael Minetti tells comely client Lily Harrison after a singularly savage slice of sacasm.

"Do I?" she replies.

But before "Six Dance Lessons in Six Week" takes its bows, she does, and so did Sunday's elite audience at the Park School on Harlem Road, cheering as loudly as any who'd watched the Bills' simultaneous winning field goal.

Although on the order of "Golden Girl Meets Arthur Murray," the top-notch production by O'Connell and Company offers sage, bittersweet and usually hilarious council on aging and relationships, with very little on where to put your feet during the fox trot.

Contracting through a rent-an-Astaire agency per-



haps peculiar to the neck of the woods later described as "Heaven's boot camp," Lily is confronted by rookie Michael, waltzing in with a chip on his shoulder big enough to support the Bolshoi Ballet. So humble an inquiry as to whether to pay him fore or aft touches him off. Clearly, these two dance to different drummers, one of whom may be in another hemisphere. Then there's the perpetual call from a downstairs neighbor, complaining of the noise.

Javier Bustillos directs seven scenes with precision, not haste, and if you think you missed something, fear not, it'll be along in the next. That's one of its many charms, that each scene seems to repeat the form of its predecessor – entrance, angry exchange of dueling profilers, phone from below, accommodation, dance, fade to black. It's repetitive comedy in its finest design.

Until the very end, not one turn of events or disclosure is unpredictable. Even clumsy Rocket Man could see that this is not Lily's first time at the rodeo. Why does one so agile need instruction? Or is it just directorial oversight? Trust Bustillos, and most in the audience will feel very wise.

Anne Gayley and Gregory Giurich are splendid. each in their own way. Playwright Richard Alferi has bestowed on him the better lines, on her the more subtly layered character. Gjurich speaks of his mother's death. She, fresh from a recent and justifiable fury, ratchets down: "Oh, I'm sorry, that was so...recent." It's a throwaway line. Gaylev frames it and could sell it on the Internet. Beauti-

In mini-irony, Lily's husband's appears in a framed photo atop a table. It's MANNY FRIED, for crying out loud, one final appearance for the late theater superstar. Funny, he doesn't look like a Baptist minister. Pamela Snyder's costume choices enhance every scene.

Fortunately, "Dance Lessons" runs for five weeks, two of which remain, Thursdays through Sundays at 4625 Harlem Rd., Snyder. Alert: A couple of f-bombs hit their targets with a great fallout of laughter and the relationships paddle outside the mainstream. Rocket Man detected no objections from the most prim of Sunday's throng. NINE Rockets (out of 10).

It became Bob and John's LA Hacienda and not too long later dropped the LA Hacienda. We became good friends when they decided to put a quarter page ad in the Rocket every week, which they did.

In the early days, the

two brothers made the pizzas and the two wives Marge and Jane waited on tables. No need to go any further as we all know the success of the operation over the years. Both brothers were athletes and were especially good at basketball. I played in a charity game with them and Tony Masiello to raise fund for Cooley's anemia.

Bob was the more outgoing of the two but John had a certain charm about him. Even though he referred to people he did not like as "pukes", his caring personality would show through. Even under that gruff exterior and those who know him know of what I speak, he was a very kind person. I am sure there are hundreds of people who can testify to that and I am one of them.

There are people you know of, people you do know, acquaintances, friends, good friends, best of friends and your best friend. If you live long enough your best friend may change over

the years. I would say John and I were best of friends. I say that as he did at one point help me out personally and I will forever be in his debt for that. A true friend who came through for me in a time of need. I was not a relative but a friend who needed some help. I did not even ask and he was there for me. That people, is the kind of man this fellow was. Believe me when I tell you I am not the only one who can say

At the wake today

there were well over two hundred people and I would hate to be one of the drivers waiting for the funeral to pass. Must have been a mile long. A fitting tribute to a man who did do much for so many. I do believe he is in a place where there are no "pukes"! So long good buddy, rest in peace. Now you can smoke all you want and not have to worry about it.





and warm heating season by following these simple safety tips:

- Make sure you have working smoke detectors installed as required.
- Make sure that you have working carbon monoxide detectors installed as required.
- Keep a working fire extinguisher on hand.
- Furnaces and other

heating sources should be inspected annually by professionals.

- Kitchen stoves/ovens should not be used as a source of heat.
- Ensure that the area around your heat sources is clean and free of debris and flammable materials.
- Never use gas or diesel powered generators in the home or in confined spaces.

Additionally, for the more than one-third of Americans that use fireplaces, wood stoves and other heat sources as their primary source of heat:

- Keep fireplaces, wood stoves, pellet stoves, etc., clean by having a certified chimney specialist inspect and clean them annually.
- Safely burn fuels use appropriate fuels never use accelerants to start the fire.
- Never leave fires unattended.
- Ensure the safety of children and pets.
- Use common sense.

The West Side Rowing Club was founded in 1912 with a mission to promote the advancement of the physical, mental, and moral well being of the youth of the City of Buffalo, New York and surcommunities rounding by education, training, instruction, and participation in the sport of rowing. In 1921, West Side became the first rowing club in the United States to sponsor public high school rowing programs. Throughout itsyears, West Side has won countless national and international championship events, having sent over 30 athletes to represent the United States at the Olympic Games and Elite World Championships, and advanced hundreds of youth athletes to top collegiate schools and rowing programs across North America. In 2007, the Frank Lloyd Wright designed Fontana Boathouse opened adjacent to the Doc Schaab Boathouse to form the West Side Rowing Club Campus. With two boathouses, over 100 shells, 400 feet of dock, 20,000+ square feet of indoor training space and the only indoor rowing tank in Western New York, the West Side Rowing Campus is the premier rowing and training center in Buffalo and one of the top training centers in the United States.
