



## Demolition Started on North Buffalo Church



The former North Park Baptist Church is being demolished after being severely damaged by an arson fire last spring.

Demolition began last Friday on the former North Park Baptist Church at the corner of Colvin and Tacoma Avenues. The building had been vacant since 2006, when a Korean Methodist congregation left for a location in Amherst.

In April a fire, that was ruled an arson, caused \$250,000 in damage, and the owner's representa-

tives said the fire and subsequent water damage made the building unsafe.

The demolition of the church building, that stood for nearly 100 years, got under way Friday, after the city issued a permit for the work earlier that day.

The United Methodist Church Upper New York Annual Conference, the building's owner, received

the permit for demolition in the standard process.

Neighbors of the church generally wanted to save the building and see it turned into apartments or a community center, though some thought it should be torn down.

The future use for the land, or a decision to put it up for sale, will be made by the church's board of trustees.
