Easter is a Christian festival and holiday celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ on the third day after his crucifixion at Calvary as described in the New Testament.

Easter is the culmination of the Passion of Christ, pre-

ceded by Lent, a forty-day period of fasting, prayer, and penance.

The last week of Lent is called Holy Week, and it contains the days of the Easter Triduum, including Maundy Thursday (also known as Holy Thursday), commemorating the Last Supper and its preceding foot washing, as well as Good Friday, commemorating the crucifixion and death of Jesus.

Say Yes Buffalo urges all seniors at public and charter schools in the City of Buffalo that have not yet submitted a Say Yes Buffalo Scholarship Application to do so by the April 1, 2013 deadline. Applications are available at www.SayYesBuffalo.org and from each school's guidance departments.

To be eligible for a Say Yes Buffalo Scholarship a student must:

- Reside in the city of Buffalo.
- Have been continuously

enrolled at a public or charter high school located in the city of Buffalo from at least 9th-12th grades. (Or are legally designated as having refugee status on an Arrival-Departure Record (I-94) from U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) or be an otherwise eligible noncitizen).

Graduate from a public or charter school located in the city of Buffalo in June 2013 or after.

The Adventures of...

Rocket Man

'Clarence Darrow'

Rather than livestream the Conservative Political Action Committee Saturday, Rocket Man opted to patronize Subversive Theatre Collective in the decommissioned Pierce Arrow Building, 225 Great Arrow, near Elmwood.

What ignited his boosters was the play "Clarence Darrow." He'd flickered across Niagara Regional Theatre Guild's "Inherit the Wind," which depicts the pioneering civil liberties attorney, if not actually by name. That was fun, this was an education, a living, breathing autobiography.

At Subversive, Fredonia State professor James Ivey's Darrow contrasts starkly with the "hulking, brute of a man" described in "Wind," actualized for NRTG by St. Joe's teacher Steve Jakiel. Ivey's Darrow is mild in both décor and decibels, quietly fervent. Rocket Man was reminded of long-gone Ch. 4 weatherman Ted Textor, a good man doomed by bland demeanor.

Ivey unerringly led Darrow into senior citizenry, walk and talk both slowing, but not his

nimble mind, always keen for a new injustice to combat. He doubted afterlife but did not fear it: "I've got good friends in both places." He opposed the death penalty, "but there were some obituary notices I read with approval."

Tom Loughlin directs from David Rintel's script with authentic precision in a cold, intimate "black box" seating 40, with considerable "date-movie" cuddling as "Darrow" began.

"Clarence Darrow" takes its own shots at the profession: "I did no more work since I became a lawyer," and "most lawyers like to say more than is absolutely necessary." He describes the pain of defending the seemingly indefensible, notably child-murdering thrill-killers Leopold and Loeb.

He did not "get them off," as "Inherit the Wind" claims, but steered them from the gallows, sentences of life plus 99 years, "Ninety-nine years more than I'd hoped for."

"Clarence Darrow" insists that he never brought his strengths "against the weak"

(where would he have been on the Corasanti hit-run matter?), concluding "the world doesn't change without trouble." (Some like it not.) "Clarence Darrow's" intense, informative testimony (two hours, one recess) reconvenes Friday at 8, Saturday at 3 and 8 through March 30. NINE ROCKETS (out of 10).

Subversive Collective wears its grudge on its sleeve, categorizing donors as Sympathizers, Fellow Travelers, Rabble Rousers, Agitators and Cadre. Its "manifesto" champions activism. Copy that. Had Rocket Man been any more active, he'd have had to dial 9-11, making three roundtrips of the building's frightful staircases, once getting lost in the basement. (A van had obscured STC's two-foot sign.)

"The building owners won't let us put up anything bigger," said an actor operating the freight elevator. (In collectives, everyone does everything; on the first try, he missed the floor. Vertical GPS, anyone?) Eventually, like ferryman Charon, he delivered Rocket Man to this third-floor underworld.

So what does it say that Rocket Man accepted the Collective's generous invitation to act in a new Darrow play, "The Mark of Cain," Monday at 7, same location? Hold the elevator.

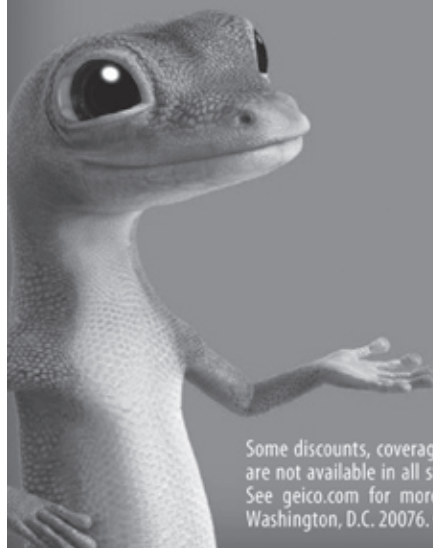

" Why the annual Scajaquada Expressway slaughter of lightpoles?

Once again we are witness to the annual end of winter slaughter of the lightpoles and mangling of the guardrails on the Scajaquada Expressway. This road was badly designed, slicing through Delaware Park and jammed on top of Scajaquada Creek. Vehicles speeds on the roadway are too high, the road has short and hairpin geometry for exits and entrances, it injects salt and volatile organic compounds into the

Scajaquada Creek tributary to Niagara River and its drinking water supply for thousands of Americans and Canadians, and creates excess noise and air pollution for the Albright, Delaware Park, Grant Amherst, Pan Am and Parkside neighborhoods. There once was a placid Scajaquada Parkway, let's see an Olmsted style public work heal this yearly wound.

It's time for the Department of Transportation

to get back on track with the safety improvements that the public needs, and to fulfill the community vision of turning this dangerous highway into a peaceful parkway.
