"The Flavors of Italy" is the theme for the 2015 Galbani Italian Heritage Festival on Hertel Avenue, which runs Thursday, July 16th through Sunday, July 19th.

Hundreds of thousands of Western New Yorkers turn out every year to celebrate one of Buffalo's biggest ethnic festivals. This year's Galbani Italian Heritage Festival will be held July 16th - 19th, from 11 am to 10 pm on Hertel Avenue, between Delaware and Colvin.

Visitors to the festival will enjoy a vast variety of Italian food from over 100 vendors such as: cannoli, gelato, Italian ice, pasta dishes, pizza, Italian sausage, stuffed artichokes, peppers, carduni, eggplant, and bruschetta to name just a few, along with some American favorites as well.

The festival is organized by three non-profit groups: The Hertel Business Association, West Side Business and Taxpayers Association, and The North Buffalo Community Center, where all proceeds from the festival are distributed and then used for community programs.

The Natural in Shoshone Park

While the North Park Theater was showing the 1983 Tri-Star Pictures release of the movie The Natural this past weekend, just down the Avenue in Shoshone Park, the Hertel North Park Youth Baseball League was playing host to real-life Naturals.

Three North Buffalo baseball teams competed against as many as seven other Leagues from across the area in WNY State Championships as a part of Cal Ripken Baseball. Cal Ripken Baseball is a division of Babe Ruth League, Inc, one of the best organizations nationally for amateur athletics that North Buffalo has been a part of since the mid 1980's. Hosting a tournament of such competition is evidence of North Buffalo's commitment to Youth Baseball and the amount of work volunteers do to bring something like this together and have it be successful.

"You have a tremendous core of individuals here in North Buffalo led by your president Don Morris," said local Babe Ruth Commissioner David Franknecht, "who have come together repeatedly to be a worthy opponent and support the Babe Ruth program here in Western New York. All visiting teams into this City of Buffalo in Shoshone Park know of the class and sportsmanship you bring to the Baseball diamonds."

In Opening Ceremonies held on Saturday, Morris proclaimed over a live microphone "that all the players, (as many as 260 boys) are all considered champions of the baseball diamonds and urged all boys to turn around and thank their coaches and then their parents for taking the time

to help their careers."

Trophies were handed out to winning teams as well as medallions around a players neck and new caps to wear.

Lou Gehrig from Amherst won the 12 and under Championship, their third year in a row. The League is located in Amherst and was coached by John Armento and for him, the victory was extremely gratify-

ing for the 40 year old man who was born and raised here in North Buffalo and learned to play baseball in Shoshone Park with his older brother Tom.

"Mr. Morris was my coach in 1990 when we went to the State finals," he said afterward. "I learned a lot from him as well as Murph (Mike Murphy), Carl Panzarella and Bob Ryan. This is still a great Park and I'm glad

some people are still around helping the next generation."

This past Monday, the League picked right back up again after the holiday with make ups and in-house Tournament games in all divisions. The green and gold colored Blaze and the purple and black Wild Cats continue their schedules against all opponents who dare to enter Shoshone Park.


