

'A Little Night Music'

From coquettes to clowns, it's all smiles for "A Little Night Music" at Irish Classical Theater. The Stephen Sondheim tuner inspired by Ingmar Bergman's movie "Smiles of a Summer Night" dots its i's – infidelity, irony and insults – with precision.

And it has to. The squared circle of the Andrews playhouse affords no place to hide. Even the last row – the third – sits so close to the stage that actors are sometimes behind. Matt Witten, playing attorney Fredrik Egerman, the Scandinavian Cellino, carries his frown right out the door.

"Night Music's" couplings could confound the canniest of cartographers. Frederik, wed to giddy teen trophy Anne, chooses to visit old flame actress Desiree, she involved with

a pompous, pistol-packin' soldier himself married to Countess Charlotte. Although Anne and Fredrik said their "I Do's" 11 months ago, they haven't "done it" yet. He is, as he says, "deflated." (Even in a downtown theater, there's no escaping Tom Brady.)

Also in the mix: Fredrik's seething seminarian son Henrik, Desiree's darling daughter Fredrika (11), Desiree's regal mother gathering them all for a showdown and Anne's robustly randy maidservant Petra. Director Chris Kelly plays the farce card gently, not a door-slam in 2 ½ hours, but Fredrik's episode in a purloined nightshirt about shakes the house to its foundations, or was that a passing streetcar?

"Night Music's" signature "Send in the Clowns" is sung bittersweetly and beautifully by Witten and Jenn Stafford, along with the sharply ironic, lesser known "You Must Meet My Wife." Renee Landrigan has a blast as the clueless Anne. Faith Walh plays the "little girl" with remarkable maturity while fully maintaining her childish charm. Also in a universally skilled and well-cast ensemble: Amy Jakiel as the maid on the make, Ben Caldwell as the seminarian ("Being young is ridiculous enough") and Pamela Rose Mangus overseeing it all to her own final curtain.

But it's soldier Anthony Alcocer, duelist at the drop of a kroner, who steals the show, or at least takes it prisoner. They call him a pea brain; sounds like crop failure from here. Michele Marie Roberts provides him a fine sounding board, a knowing but still offended wife, coldly referencing Desiree's "very remote youth." Mee-ow!

In the musical ensemble, Kirsten Fisher and Keith Galantowicz excel on violin and reeds.

"Night Music's" attitude toward even "retroactive infidelity" seems downright forgiving, but in the North Country, nights are long. So is the run, five shows at week through Oct. 18 at 625 Main. NINE ROCK-ETS (out of 10.)

TRAFFIC'S BACK-This was Rocket Man's first theater-district launch since autos returned to Main Street. He and the First Mate had a delightful preshow conversation with a senior musician on a bench out front, he claiming to have walked all the way from Minnesota Street just to people watch. And afterward, a wedding reception seemed to have taken over the neighborhood, a fitting postscript to the connubial shenanigans on stage.



"Coming together at the Making Strides walk gives us power to make a






