Elmwood Village Park & Ride Program Announced

Mayor Byron Brown, Delaware District Councilmember Joel P. Feroletto, Niagara District Councilmember David A. Rivera, and the Elmwood Village Association announced their partnership on a brand-new park & ride program for visitors to the Elmwood Village during the holiday season.

Starting this weekend, the Elmwood Village will become holiday central, with visitors from all over Western New York and Southern Ontario arriving to shop, dine, and get into the holiday spirit in one of Buffalo's most vibrant neighborhoods. The park & ride initiative, along with an exciting slate of holiday events, builds on the popularity of the Elmwood Village as a destination and makes it even more attractive to visit Buffalo's local and independently-owned businesses this holiday season.

New this year, visitors will enjoy a free Holiday Shopping & Dining Shuttle sponsored by Delaware District Councilmember Joel P. Feroletto. The shuttle will run on Saturdays from noon to midnight, beginning November 28th and continuing through December 19th; stops will be located every few blocks along Elmwood Ave. from Forest Ave. to Allen St.

"I am thrilled to sponsor this pilot program on behalf of Elmwood businesses", said Councilmem-

ber Feroletto. "Shopping local is especially important this time of year... the free shuttle makes it even more convenient for visitors and residents alike to appreciate all that this neighborhood has to offer."

Additionally, Mayor Byron Brown has waived parking fees in the Gallagher Parking Ramp (located on Elmwood between Hodge Ave. and Utica St.) for shuttle riders each Saturday. "Buffalo welcomes the increase in visitors to our city's shopping and dining districts, particularly during the holidays, and we're pleased to play a role in launching the brand-new pilot park & ride program for visitors to the Elmwood Village by providing free parking at the Gallagher Parking Ramp on Saturdays during the holidays," said Mayor Brown. "As part of administration's ongoing effort to drive business to stores and restaurants in Buffalo, and to make it easier to park in our shopping districts citywide, we're also pleased to announce that the city will suspend parking meter enforcement on Friday, November 27th, making parking free at all its metered spaces on "Black Friday", as well as on December 23rd, 24th and 31st."

Niagara District Councilmember David A. Rivera hopes the park & ride will ease the demand for parking as well as give

shoppers a better opportunity to experience the area's shops and nightlife as a pedestrian. "I commend Mayor Brown and Commissioner of Parking Kevin Helfer for offering free parking on Black Friday and at the Gallagher Ramp. We want to encourage shoppers to buy local and support our small businesses this holiday season. I also applaud Council Member Feroletto and the Elmwood Village Association for a creative,

fun solution to ease parking congestion along Elmwood Avenue this shopping season. The trolley will be a great addition to the neighborhood."

Holiday events in the Elmwood Village include the Black Friday Boutique Crawl (Friday, November 27th from 9 am to 12 pm), Small Business Saturday (Saturday, November 28th), EVergreen Holiday Bazaar (Saturdays, November 28th through December 19th from 8 am to

1 pm), Christmas in the Village (Thursday, December 10th through Saturday December 12th), and Men's Shopping Night (Thursday, December 17th from 5 pm to 9 pm). The schedule of events and event details can be found on the Elmwood Village Association website (www.elmwoodvillage.org).





Food Safety and Cooking Tips for Your Thanksgiving Turkey

Thanksgiving is the largest meal many cooks prepare every year. Its centerpiece—the turkey—is the largest dish most cooks ever encounter, and many are not experienced at roasting one. USDA wants consumers to know that a range of resources, from smartphone apps to its 30-year Meat and Poultry Hotline, exist to help consumers through any food preparation conundrums this holiday season, wherever and whenever they may arise.

“Unsafe handling and undercooking of your turkey can lead to serious foodborne illness,” said Al Almanza, USDA Deputy Under Secretary for Food Safety. “USDA’s Food Safety and Inspection Service has a variety of food safety resources to help with any questions related to preparing Thanksgiving dinner, including our Meat and Poultry Hotline that will be staffed with helpful experts on Thanksgiving Day.”

This Thanksgiving more than 46 million turkeys will be eaten. Cooking the Thanksgiving turkey can be tricky, and trying to figure out when

the turkey is done is often the hardest task. But, it doesn’t have to be! Impress your family by using a food thermometer to cook like a PRO: Place the thermometer, Read the temperature, Out of the oven.

Place the thermometer in the innermost part of the thigh, the innermost part of the wing, and the thickest part of the breast.

Read the temperature to make sure that the bird has reached a minimum internal temperature of 165°F.

Take the turkey **Out** of the oven, and serve it to your family without worry!

If you have questions about your Thanksgiving dinner, you can call the USDA Meat & Poultry Ho-

tline at 1-888-MPHotline (1-888-674-6854) to talk to a food safety expert. The Hotline has been around for 30 years. Last November they received more than 3000 calls mostly about Thanksgiving dinner. You can also chat live with a food safety expert at AskKaren.gov, available from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm ET, Monday through Friday, in English and Spanish.

If you need help on Thanksgiving Day, the Meat & Poultry Hotline phone line is available from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm ET.

Consumers with more food safety questions can visit FoodSafety.gov to learn more about how to safely select, thaw, and prepare a turkey.

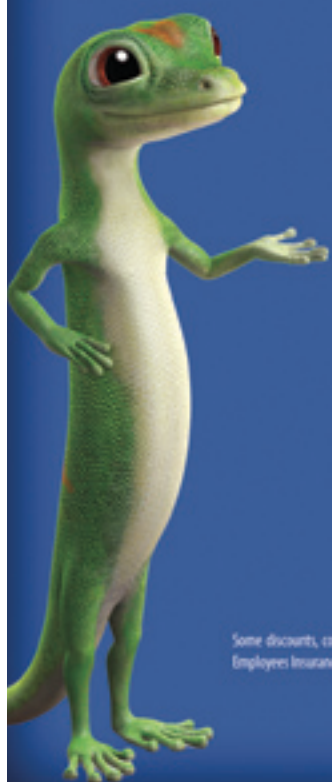
