So we can't specifically lay the blame on the Buffalo News, although some edi-

tor there might have been able to right the wrong with at least a qualifying "what some feel are the excesses, etc. etc."

The News seems to have pulled back a little from its affection for all things liberal and for a while, at least, it seemed as if the editor whose only task was to get Hillary Clinton's picture into the paper was granted early retirement.

But it's still there. Not quite to excess, but Rocket Man will re-activate his scanner.

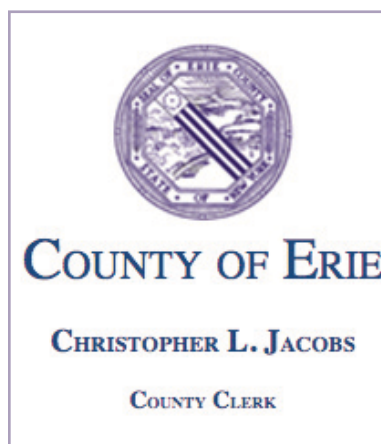

Discount cards will be issued to honorably discharged veterans who file their original DD-214 (discharge papers) with the Erie County Clerk's Office.

Veterans can use the Clerk's "Thank-A-Vet" card at over 1,200 participating local businesses who have agreed to honor the card with a discount on purchases or services.

"My office continues our effort to recognize



the service and sacrifices made by Erie County veterans through this important program," stated Jacobs.

"We are pleased to work with the North Buffalo Community Development Corporation in order to provide a convenient location for veterans to place their DD-214's on

file with County Clerk's Office," he added.

For the veteran, filing discharge papers is free of charge and certified complimentary copies of recorded discharges are made for veterans or their immediate families whenever needed.

Original discharge papers are proof of military service and can be used to establish eligibility for a variety of benefits including property tax exemptions and civil service credits.

# The Grapevine

**The Resource Training Center of Amherst and S.E.R.V. Niagara** are teaming up to offer a unique scholarship for veterans of the United States armed forces. Through the Gary L. Valeri Scholarship Program, veterans will be trained to work as Credentialed Alcohol and Substance Abuse Counselors.

The training program, offered two nights per week over an 11-month period, will qualify veterans to work with other veterans in a wide variety of settings such as clinics, hospitals, veterans facilities, halfway houses and the court system.


