painters are working diligently to complete the project.

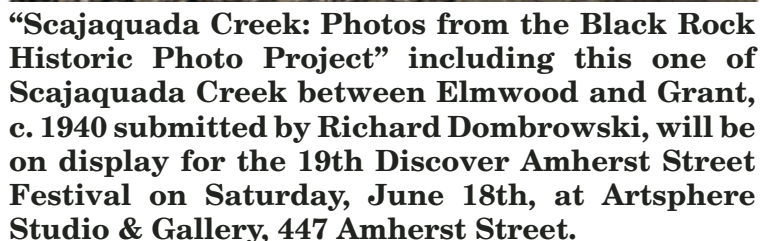

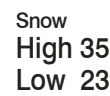
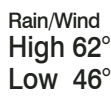

New "State" of the Bills, Sabres

Assessing the ascendancy of athletic programs at the largest local state-operated university, officials of both the Buffalo Bills and Buffalo Sabres are preparing a daring move designed to advance their teams to the post-season. Effective tomorrow (Friday), they will be known as the New York State Bills and New York State Sabres.

Playoff time has eluded both the local football and hockey teams since within the lifetimes of many of their fans. Meanwhile, their collegiate counterparts have dominated the local media, especially this year, when the "Bulls" sent both men's and women's teams to the basketball competition colloquially known as "March Madness."

Rocket Man pioneered coverage of this trend in a column Oct. 7, 2013, after watching, on his mute TV, a blue-clad team with "New York" on its uniforms, run-

ning all over an opponent he mis-identified as "Easy Michigan." It wasn't 'til he picked up the Buffalo News the next day that he realized that he had actually watched the University of Buffalo defeating Eastern Michigan 42-14.

"I can't help wondering, though," he said to himself, "why a Buffalo team, with such a legacy and reputation, would write 'New York' all over its uniforms." He learned later than the current athletic director thought it might be easier to tap into big alumni contributions by convincing entities east of Syracuse that the school was actually from "New York," not Buffalo. Even on the gymnasium floor, "New York" supplanted "Buffalo."

Loopy though the idea might seem, there is no doubt that the "New York" Bulls have done better than the old "UB" Bulls. Ms. Zing Link, noted behavioral sci-

entist and consultant to professional sports organizations, concluded that the city's athletic shortcomings lie not with its players, but its name. As Rocket Man says about upstate weather, "Watertown gets the cold, Syracuse gets the snow, Buffalo gets the blame."

For both teams, though, an image problem remains. Their emblems depict buffalo, or bison, if you will, the Sabres above a pair of crossed swords, the Bills in the form of a silhouette charging from left to right. As any silhouette of the Empire State tends to look like a hunchback slug, moving right to left (Long Island as the tail, Niagara Falls as the forehead), the challenge remains to convert this into some sort of threatening beast.

Otherwise, despite a drumbeat of letters-to-the-editor criticism of the "New Yorking" of UB, the university's new athletic director has shown no disposition to reinstate the old-school policy of admitting that it's actually in Buffalo.

Other teams purporting to represent New York in the National Football League while actually playing in New Jersey, have shown no inclination to impede this advancement to a new "state" of professional athletics in Western New York.

Lest this entire situation somehow make sense to you, Rocket Man recommends checking the calendar for a reminder of Friday's date, or assembling the first letters of each of these paragraphs.

is facing Niagara Street, is a huge counterweight fixture with a large flat surface. Planners are taking suggestions on what to do with that large highly visible area of the bridge. Thousands of cars traveling on the I-190 pass it every day and this creates a great opportunity to send

a message from the bridge about our great city. Some suggestions include a portrait of a sitting or past mayor of the city or perhaps a mural of some sort depicting the treasures of the Queen City. Ms. Loof Lipra, a member of the planning committee states that this

highly visible structure can't just be "covered with paint" and included "what a great opportunity to promote those involved with the rebirth of our city." Hundreds of ideas are pouring in to the bridge planners and a decision will be made on what to put on that area of the bridge on Friday, April 1st.

connection shine between Delaware Park and the Niagara Riverwalk. Buffalo Niagara Riverkeeper has taken the Grant Amherst Business Association's two decades-long Scajaquada Clean-up initiative and grown it into a community-wide Shoreline Sweep. The Scajaquada clean-up has even been subdivided into four sites due to the strong interest from participants. The day of-

fers the opportunity to share in the Creek clean-up with hundreds of dedicated neighbors, groups, students and environmental advocates. This year it will be a safer site to clean up because of the slower speed limit, lower sound level and less airborne pollution. Riverkeeper is also creating public access and environmental remediation by developing the Scajaquada Creek Park and

Paddlesports Launch on Niagara Street. The Scajaquada Clean-up is from 10 am to Noon, meeting at the American Legion on Amherst Street. There will be a Volunteer Appreciation Party after the cleanup at 12:30 pm at the West Side Rowing Club. Prior registration to attend the party is mandatory because of limited space. 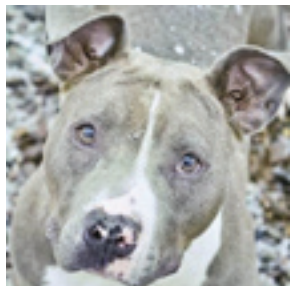
