This summer's amazing season, the 41st season of free professional outdoor theater, will begin June 23rd with *The Winters Tale*. It is interesting to note that *The Winters Tale* was Shakespeare in Delaware Park's very first production in 1976 and will now be the first production on the brand new stage in 2016. Founder and artistic director Saul Elkin directs Matt Witen, Patrick Moltane, Jenn Stafford, Lisa Vit-rano, and Tom Loughlin in this production known as one of Shakespeare's late romances.

The crowd pleasing *Taming of the Shrew* will be the second offering of the summer featuring Chris Hatch, Bonnie Jean Taylor, Rolando Gomez and Norm Sham directed by Steve Vaughan. The courtship of Petruchio and Kate hits the stage on July 28th.

Shakespeare in Delaware Park reaches over 40,000 audience members each season and is excited to be celebrating 41 incredible years of high-quality professional theatre. This event remains as one of the largest free outdoor

children can tell you today about growing up in Shoshone Park and having their Dad as a coach. Now Tera's son Hunter, age 11 and daughter Giana, age 9 are both Giants on two different teams while Frank's son, Frankie, age 12, also plays with Hunter on the same team. Two other sons, Joe and Louis, all learned the game from their father while growing up like stairs, close together in the Linden and Sterling neighborhood. Joe tells us the story.

"This was a community of families who all grew up together, on the same street or a few streets over," Joe recalled recently. "Everyone knew their neighbors and would be outside in the summer months to share ways to have fun. My sons would find friends like the Dentico's or the Ruggerio's and play pick up games over at Nichols or St. Margaret's School and play from sun up til sun down. We wouldn't have to worry where they were. When the street lights came on, they would head for home."

During these early years in Hertel North Park, girls played with the boys on teams like Tigers and Giants, Angels and Yankees or Reds and Cardinals. It

wasn't until the early 1980's when a whole division was set up with girls teams like Tigerettes. Tera, the youngest in the DiLeo family remembers those days. In fact, she considers her ponytail experience with head coach John Tripi the most memorable of her young life. Besides coaching her Tigerette team to a Championship, Tripi was also the League's president at the time and made sure each child was learning the game and having fun.

"He was a terrific coach, a mentor and a friend," she said. "He would never yell and scream at you out on the diamond even though his voice was loud and could carry. He never held a grudge and as soon as the game was over, he could make you laugh. There isn't a day that goes by where I don't think of him, especially here in Shoshone. Even when I was going to Holy Angels Academy and had left the Park, the memories stayed with me."

Frank DiLeo has been the coach for City Honors High School for over ten years now and credits his father for all he knows about the game. Besides having his dad as a coach in the Hertel North Park League, he shares his sister's view of

Tripi as a coach and mentor. Amazingly, while serving as president and coaching, Tripi had no other family members playing or coaching in North Buffalo. "Tripi taught us the fundamentals of the game," he said recently. "He wanted us to have fun while learning to play baseball. There are many good memories of me with my brothers with my Dad. I couldn't be anywhere without him."

This is Giana's first year playing in Shoshone Park for a Giants team that has yet to win many games, but she says she's still having fun. Her brother Hunter was a part of an Athletics team last season which won a championship in First Minors. Now, as a member of a Giants team in the Majors with his cousin Frankie, victories are hard to come by sometimes in little league. It's not San Francisco even though the caps look the same.

Antoinette DiLeo puts everything in perspective. "Through the years my love for baseball has not diminished. I watched my husband play and would pack my stroller, snacks and diaper bag and four children along to Houghton, Shoshone or Front Parks. Now I sit here watching the next generation of DiLeo's play and remember the days when I was a young girl watching the Bisons play near my father's barber-shop on Main Street and West Ferry in the 1950's. I plan on being at the park for a long time."
