Doug Smith, long-time columnist known to North Buffalo readers as “Rocket Man,” has been selected for the Western New York Baseball Hall of Fame.

Nominated by Grand Island High School Athletic Director Jon Roth and Hall of Fame baseball manager Al Chester, Smith will be inducted September 14th at the Lake Erie Italian Club, 3200 South Park Ave., Blasdell. The ceremony follows a 7:30 pm dinner to be served by the caterers of Ilio DiPaolo’s

Restaurant.

Smith, with his wife Polly, lifted off to Cortland, NY in late March to be nearer to family. He will return for the ceremony, along with their children and his brother Robert. He is active in Cortland-area baseball as a scorekeeper, umpire and coach.

While most members of the Hall of Fame are selected for their on-field accomplishments, Smith played the game with far more enthusiasm than skill. The Hall of Fame commit-

School is Open... Drive Carefully







The majority of Buffalo schools start on Wednesday, September 7th. Please remember that it is illegal, and very dangerous, to pass a stopped school bus when the large red lights are flashing. Flashing lights indicate the bus is picking up or discharging students and many of these children need to

cross the street. You must stop whether you are approaching the school bus from the front or behind, even on a divided or multilane highway. The first-time fine for illegally passing a school bus is a \$250 to \$400 fine, 5 points on your license, and or up to 30 days in jail.

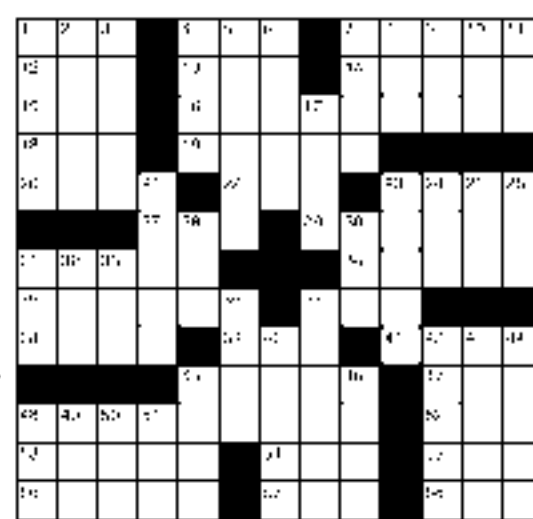

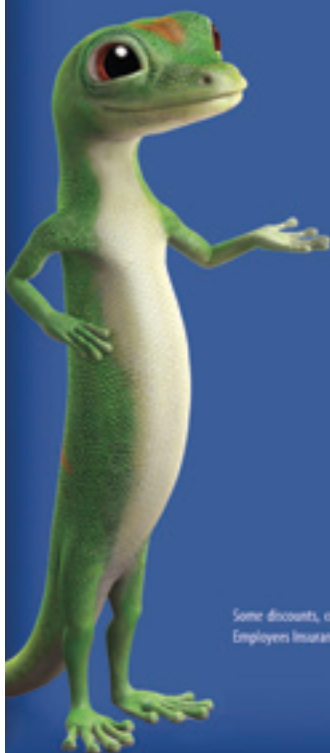

open at Coca Cola Field at 8 am, and the walk kicks off at 10 am. More than 1,000 participants are expected to attend this year's walk to beat Parkinson's. This is the foundation's largest fundraising event of the year, and the goal for 2016 is \$90,000.

There has been a nationwide effort to engage firefighters in Moving Day events across the country. Firefighters are three times more likely than the general population to receive a Parkinson's diagnosis.

Jim Schaefer, a Lancaster Fire Chief, is the Person-of-the-Year for Moving Day Buffalo. Schaefer was diagnosed with Parkinson's in his early forties, a very young age for a diagnosis. He attributes the higher case numbers among his colleagues to the hazards fires present. "Just think of all of the materials that are burning, even in a house fire, when crews arrive," he said. "Plastics, chemicals, carpeting, paint, all of these fumes fill the air, and when the air looks clear, often it isn't," he continued. Schaefer always brings a large team of walkers to Moving Day, as his fellow firefighters in Lancaster support him greatly. This year, he is also bringing along the department's new \$1.3 million ladder truck. "Having this beautiful vehicle on hand will

emphasize the connection between Parkinson's and firefighters," added Chris Jamele, executive director. "We have reached out to every fire company in Western New York, attempting to make them aware of the risk and asking them to get involved in the walk this year," he said. Every firefighter who registers for Moving Day Buffalo will be recognized on a National Firefighters Team.

Jamele suggested that this is the perfect pre-game warm up for the Buffalo Bills' season opener. "Come out for a short, invigorating walk, have some coffee, help some of your fellow Western New Yorkers, and then head to your favorite viewing place for the game. The

walk is done long before kickoff."

A portion of the funding will also be used for research. Parkinson's is a chronic, neurodegenerative disease for which there is no cure.

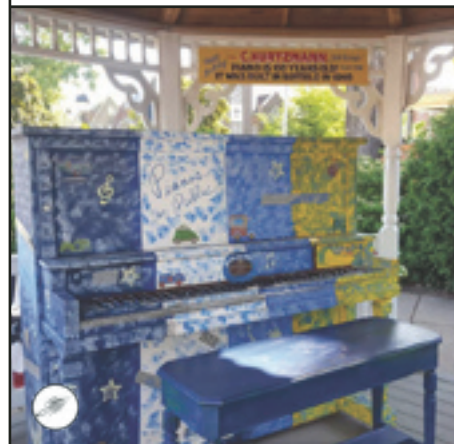
