such jury verdict in a case in Buffalo. Both times their clients were union asbestos workers. Growing up in Western New York, John N. Lipsitz and Michael A. Ponterio became acquainted with the high incidence of occupational disease among laborers at indus-

trial facilities. Gradually they expanded their practice to include other toxic exposures, such as lead paint poisoning, coke oven emissions, benzene, allergic contact dermatitis and diesel emissions. In helping victims of toxic exposure and negligence

Stephen Siller 5K Run & Walk This Weekend

On Saturday September 10th Buffalo is hosting the Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers 5K Run/Walk to mark the 15th Anniversary of the attacks of September 11, 2001.

The Stephen Siller Tunnel to Towers 5K Run/Walk is a national series of 5Ks that honors those lost in the terrorist attacks in NYC, Pennsylvania and at the Pentagon.

Named after a New York City firefighter killed in the collapse of the Twin Towers, the NYC version of this event retraces Stephen Siller’s steps as he ran through the Brooklyn/Battery Tunnel to get to the World Trade Center. Local versions of the event in 28 cities across the United States symbolically retrace these steps.

The inaugural Buffalo Run/Walk will start behind the Key Bank Center (the former First Niagara Center) and take a route through the Erie Basin

Marina. Along the route will be an “Honor Line” with over 500 signs, each with the name, picture and story of one of the First Responders killed in the collapse of the Twin Towers, the people with ties to WNY killed in NYC, Pennsylvania and at the Pentagon, and the military personnel from WNY killed in the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.

Over 500 people are expected for the Run/Walk, including firefighters in gear from departments across WNY, police officers, EMS personnel, active and former military personnel, and others from all parts of the community. Participants of all ages and capabilities are encouraged to participate in this family friendly event.

to reflect and remember them," said Leigh Macadlo, a member of the Western New York Families of September 11th. Macadlo lost her twin brother, Leonard M. Castrianno, in the 9/11 terrorist attacks. He worked for Cantor Fitzgerald on the 105th floor of One World Trade Center.

"This year, the 15th anniversary of the tragic 9/11 event, the American Red Cross is humbled and honored to host the flag display assembled by the Western New York Families of September 11th and their volunteers," said American Red Cross Western New York Chapter Executive Director Chuck Marra.
