This week's recipe comes to us from long time reader Salvatore Bordonaro. Sal has been reading the Buffalo Rocket since it first started publishing in 1969. We appreciate Sal's interest in the Buffalo Rocket!

Chicken Florentine

Ingredients:

- 2-3 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 3 cups of Italian flavored bread crumbs
- 2 eggs
- 1 cup of Romano Cheese
- sprig of chopped fresh basil (or 1/4 cup dried basil)
- 3/4 cup of extra virgin olive oil.
- 2 - 12 oz. bags of spinach
- 2 - 8 oz. containers chopped fresh mushrooms
- 8 cloves garlic
- salt, black pepper, lemon juice.

Directions:

Prepare chicken by filleting thinly into cutlets and gently pounding with a steel mallet.

Beat eggs in a dish. Dip cutlets in egg batter.

Place mixture of Italian flavored bread crumbs in 9"x11" pan and add Romano cheese along with basil and mix. Bread both side

of chicken cutlets in bread crumbs. Cutlets may be placed in large plate once breaded.

Use a large frying pan with heated olive oil and 2 cloves chopped garlic. Repeat this step throughout the cooking process as needed.

Start sauteing cutlets until both side are golden brown (2-3 minutes each side) and sprinkle salt lightly on chicken. You may have to add more olive oil since bread crumbs absorb oil.

After chicken is sauteed, place pieces in a large casserole dish with cover and bake for 30-40 minutes at 300 degrees.

Use a quart size pot with 1/4 cup olive oil and brown 4 cloves garlic. Add rinsed spinach and mushrooms in water and drain. Then cook for five minutes and sprinkle salt and pepper to taste. While stirring ingredients add 1/4 cup lemon juice.

Remove from burner and pour contents over chicken cutlets and sprinkle 4 spoons of Romano cheese over spinach and mushrooms.

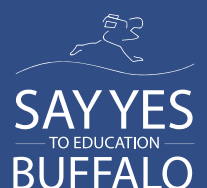
