fires. According to the National Fire Protection Association, nearly four times as many home cooking fires occur on Thanksgiving as on a typical day.

Don't let this happen to you! Take precautions in the kitchen to ensure a happy Thanksgiving for all.

The following tips can help reduce the risk of cooking fires on Thanksgiving and beyond:

**Stay in the kitchen** when cooking to keep a close eye on the food, especially when frying with oil.

**Stay alert and focused** when cooking. To help minimize the risk of injury, avoid cooking when drinking alcohol or if you're sleepy.

**Use a timer** to keep track of cooking times, most notably when cooking a meal that takes a long time like roasting

## Fedun Helps Fix Sabres

The acquisition of defense man Tyler Fedun as a free agent barely drew any attention when the Sabres signed him in the off season. And why would it? With only 12 NHL games on his resume four years into his professional career, he was clearly a depth player destined to ply his trade in Rochester for the Sabres minor league team. Fedun has bounced around to four NHL organization in five years. No other team found a reason to keep him so why expect anything special from him here? And at age 28 his best years were not ahead of him.

But a funny thing happened down the Thruway,

Fedun piled up some stats at a career best pace, going 2-10-12 in 14 games with the Amerks. It seems he has a knack for avoiding those pesky shot blocking forwards and getting the puck on net from the point. And this leads to goals and rebounds which leads to more goals. With the goal starved Sabres desperate for a cure for their sluggish offense, they put the call in for Fedun to travel to Buffalo.

Buffalo's defense corps hadn't scored a goal all season and rarely even earned assists. But in Fedun's first game Cody Franson broke the D-corps season long goose egg with Fedun earning an assist

in a 4-1 home ice loss to Tampa Bay. In his second game, his shot was deflected by rookie William Carrier for his first career goal and the Sabres broke a five game win less skid with a 2-1 OT win against Stanley Cup champion Pittsburgh. That's two games played, two regulation time goals for Buffalo and two assists for Fedun.

Then with visiting Calgary in town, and franchise defenseman Rasmus Ristolainen glued to the bench after incurring earning coach Dan Bylsma's displeasure for consistently breaking his sticks on power play one timers, Fedun added another pair of helpers in a 4-1 victory. So three games, four assists for Fedun while Ristolainen leads the team with nine assists in 19 games. While Fedun can't possibly keep up this pace, he has been the right player at the right time to help the Sabres end a miserable win less skid and start to salvage their season.

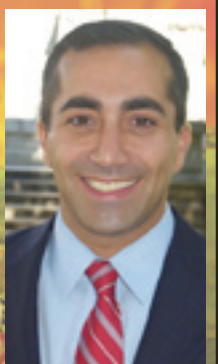

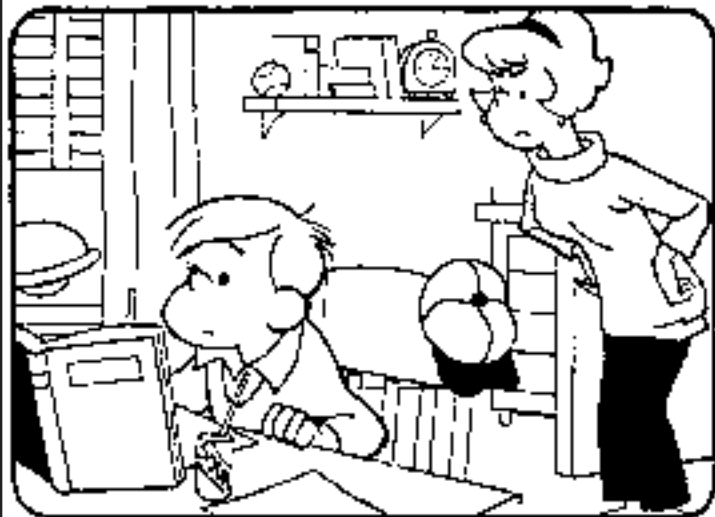

a turkey, baking a roast or simmering. Check the stove or oven frequently. Consider putting timers in different rooms so you can hear them over the music and party chatter.

**Keep things that can catch fire** like oven mitts, wooden utensils, food wrappers and towels away

Thanksgiving is also the time when many people like to experiment with frying turkeys. The National Fire Protection Association discourages the use of turkey fryers, which can lead to devastating burns and other injuries, and the destruction of property due to the

large amount and high temperature of oil used. The association urges those who prefer fried turkey to look for grocery stores, specialty food retailers and restaurants that sell deep fried turkeys.

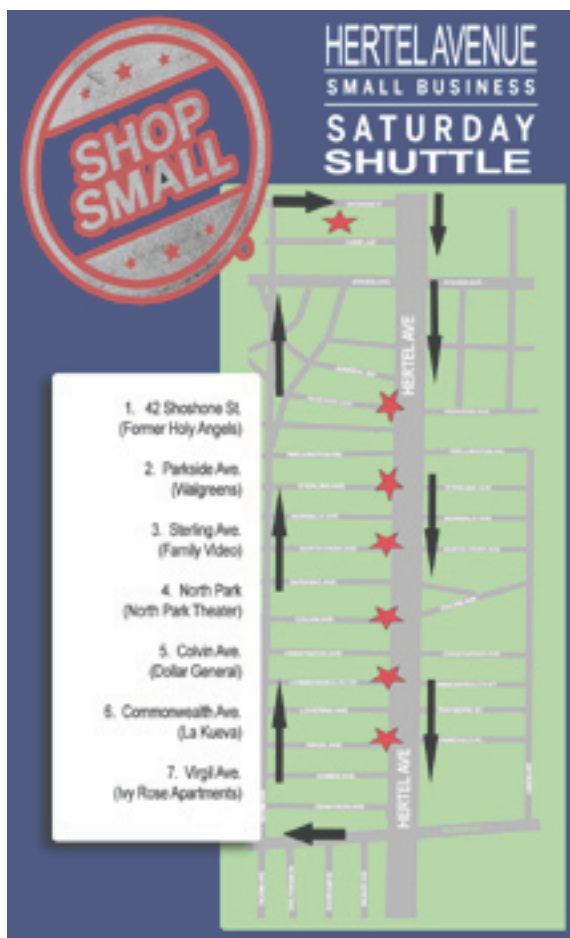

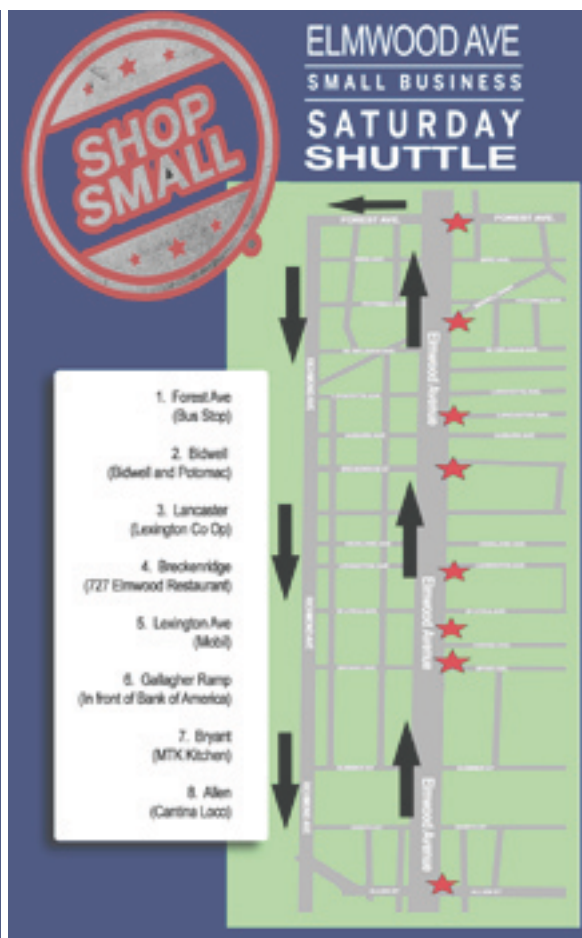

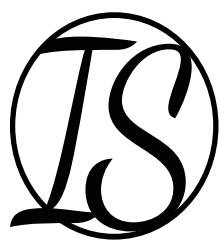
