Sabres Shootout Woes Hold Team Down

With their 4-3 shootout loss to the Florida Panthers on Tuesday December 21 st at Sunrise FL, the Sabres record in shootouts dropped to 1-5 on the season. Goaltender Robin Lehner has been perfect on shootouts, he hasn't stopped a single shooter in six attempts and has lost all three of his games that have gone to shootout.

Sabres forwards have been mostly ineffective with only three goals on 13 attempts in six shootouts. Sam Reinhart has been their most dangerous shootouts with two goals on four attempts. Cal O'Reilly has one goal on two attempts including the only shootout game winner. And that's it. No other player has scored a shootout goal this season.

The players without shootout success include Kyle Okposo with zero goals on four attempts and the trio of Brian Gionta, Ryan O'Reilly and Jack Eichel who are each scoreless in one attempt. Jack Eichel is emblematic of the Sabres shootout problems going one for seven so far in his career.

Old friends Jason Pominville and Thomas Vanek are both two for two on shootout attempts for a 100% success rate so far this season. There are 87 NHL players who

have scored a total of 116 shootout goals so far this season. Reinhart is the only NHL rostered player the Sabres have with a shootout goal this season. (Cal O'Reilly is an AHL player with Rochester).

The Sabres shootout failures make it imperative that a full out effort must be made to win games in overtime. Perhaps they should play the three on three format with three forwards and press hard for a score. It matters little if they fail and surrender a goal, they seem assured of a loss if the game is tied after the OT period and goes to a shootout. Especially when Robin Lehner is playing. Why he can't even stop a single shootout attempt is a mystery to everyone.



LOST MAP

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee a former Penn State Professor. Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of

45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill. But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in

non-photographic blue. Higher was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard Higher's dream came true. omputers made it possible to reprint the map


