Sabres Continue See Saw Season with Loss to Leafs

One step forward, one step back. Two steps forward, two steps back. That's the story of the Sabres 2016-17 season so far. With the team languishing at the bottom of the Eastern Conference standing the Sabres needed to get on a winning streak to close the distance to a playoff spot. Despite a 4-2- 1 record so far this month they hadn't made up much ground but were five points behind the Toronto Maple Leafs in the last playoff spot heading into Tuesday nights game at the Air Canada Center.

The Sabres took a 2-0 lead in the first period on goals by Kyle Okposo and Evander Kane even though the Leafs had the better of the play by a slim margin. But four straight goals by the Leafs led to an eventual 4-3 loss. Uncharacteristically it was Buffalo's goaltenders who let the team down with a pair of weak goals that pee wee net

minders would stop with ease.

With the Sabres leading 2-1, Robin Lehner was victimized at 8:29 of the second period when Matt Martin took a bad angle shot from 30 feet away near the goal line which slipped under Lehner's arm and into the net. After surrendering a goal to Leafs rookie sensation Auston Matthews Lehner was pulled having surrendered three goals on 18 shots.

His replacement Anders Nilsson stopped 15 of 16 shots, but was also vic-

timized by a goal line shot. Nilsson was on his knees positioned to defend the slot area while James van Riemsdyk held the puck down low at the goal line to the left of the Sabres net. But van Riemsdyk wisely noticed Nilsson's failure to seal the post with his body and roofed a shot from a severe angle for the eventual game winner.

Obviously the Leafs were coached to take advantage of Buffalo's vulnerable goaltenders. The loss drops Buffalo's record this month to 4-3- 1 and 43 points which is nowhere near good enough to make up ground against Toronto and Ottawa who are tied with 50 points in the last playoff spot both with two games in hand over Buffalo. The Sabres are last in the Atlantic Division and one point ahead of the woe-ful Islanders at the bottom of the Eastern Conference.
