Erie County Mock Trial Finals

The 36th Annual Erie County High School Mock Trial Championship Tournament will be held on Monday, March 20 at 5:00 p.m. in the Ceremonial Courtroom (Part I) at 92 Franklin Street in downtown Buffalo. The tournament is presented by the Bar Association of Erie County in conjunction with the New York State Bar Association's Law, Youth and Citizenship Committee and the New York Bar Foundation.

Charter School for Applied Technologies will be the plaintiff, and Iroquois



High School will be the defendant. The tournament began in January with preliminary rounds, followed by playoff rounds in February and March. There were 24 teams from Erie County schools that competed.

This year's hypothetical case, Robin Berkman v. County of Dover, involves a civil action in which a person wrongfully convicted for robbery and murder seeks monetary damages for malicious prosecution.

"The annual mock trial program affords area high school students an unparalleled opportunity to develop advocacy and basic trial practice skills," according to Craig R. Bucki, a partner in the Buffalo office of Phillips Lytle LLP, who has

Sharks Dominate Sabres 4-1 on West Coast Opener

Perhaps the San Jose Sharks are no longer the Sabres whipping boys. Even during the tank seasons the Sabres have dominated the Stanley Cup contending Sharks. Prior to Tuesday's game the Sabres were 9-0-1 in their last ten games against the Sharks. Buffalo has owned the Sharks on the road going 6-2-2 in their last ten games at the Shark Tank.

In their typical Shark fashion Tuesday night the Sabres opened the scoring just 1:10 into the game with Jack Eichel putting Josh Gorges rebound into an open net for a 1-0 lead. This was the fastest goal

the Sharks had surrendered all season. The 1-0 score held up after 20 minutes despite a 20-9 shots advantage for the Sharks as the Sabres continued their season long trend of surrendering far too many shots on goal. The 20 shots were the most the Sharks have had in any period this season.

It took the Sharks 31 shots to beat Sabres goalie Robin Lehner. "Jumbo" Joe Thornton fed Logan Couture behind the net who centered the puck to Joe Pavelski for a one timer on a power play with 8:13 left in the second period. The Sabres or any team would find it hard to

win surrendering 31 shots just past the games half way point.

The Sharks scored the winning goal on a fluke play that showed the folly of putting the puck in front of your own net. Cody Franson had the puck standing on the back wall behind the net moving to his left. He slipped a pass forward to Jack Eichel who was skating laterally to Franson's right directly in front of him. But the fore checking Michael Haley managed to tip the puck changing it's direction just slightly so that the pass hit Eichel's skate. The puck caromed off his boot and past Lehner to give the Sharks a 2-1 lead.

Pavelskis and Couture added third period scores in the Sharks 4-1 victory. San Jose dominated the game and nearly doubled the Sabres in shots 42-23. The Sabres need to reduce their opponents shots on goal. This was the Sabres fourth loss in their last five games.

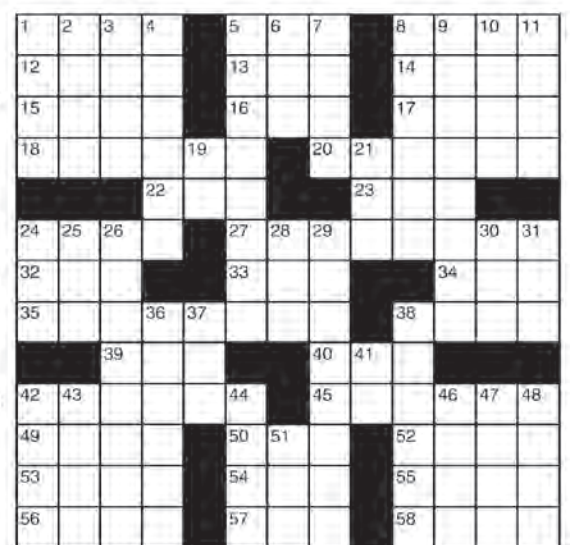

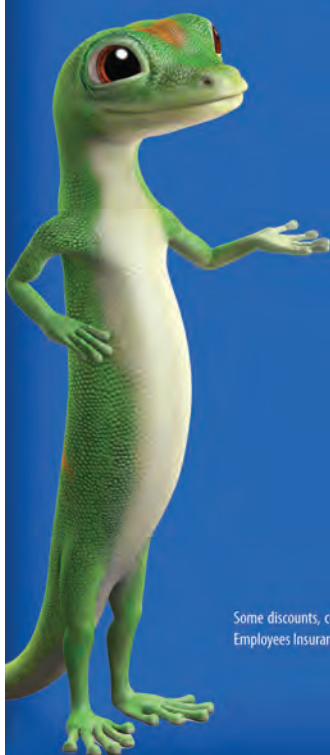

chaired the tournament for the past seven years.

Students learn how to conduct direct and cross-examinations, present opening and closing statements, analyze legal issues, and learn the dynamics of a courtroom. On average, nearly 100 lawyers and judges volunteer their time to help make the tournament a success.

"While the program fosters an understanding

of the adversarial system, it stresses the importance of professionalism and civility," Bucki said. "Students learn how to be zealous but courteous advocates for their clients."

On Saturday, April 29, Erie County will host the Region I High School Mock Trial Tournament with the best teams from Erie, Chautauqua, Genesee and Monroe Counties. The winning team will

proceed to the state finals in Albany in May.

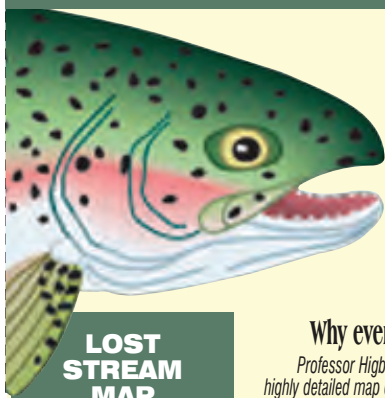

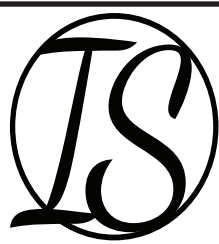
