Elmwood Village Farmers Market Returns May 13th

Weekly yoga classes, several new vendors and two visits from the Buffalo Philharmonic String Quartet are among the highlights of the upcoming Elmwood Village Farmers Market, which returns to the corner of Elmwood Avenue and Bidwell Parkway in Buffalo’s Elmwood Village on May 13th. The market will take place from 8 am to 1 pm Saturdays, rain or shine, through November 25th.

The market features approximately 40 vendors selling fruits, vegetables, baked goods, or-



ganics, fresh meat, cut flowers, wine, craft beer, eggs, dairy, honey, maple syrup, cheese and much more. Products available at the market are always fresh, seasonal and local. New vendors in 2017 include Niagara Mush-

rooms, Rooted Locally (microgreens), Lilly Belle Meads (meads made from their own bees), Heimiller Greenhouses (plants and hanging baskets) and Carla’s Crumby Creations (organic, natural cookies).

New in 2017, the market will team up with HEAL Bflo to offer free weekly yoga classes from 9 am to 10 am. Participants are asked to bring a yoga mat and a bottle of water. Classes will be offered beginning June 3 on the east side of Elmwood Avenue, directly

Annual Food Drive

The National Association of Letter Carriers and the United States Postal Service will conduct its 25th annual national food drive on Saturday, May 13th. Last year, residents donated nearly 1.3 million pounds of food for their western NY neighbors and a record 80 million pounds of food nationally.

The Stamp Out Hunger® Food Drive, the country’s largest single-day food drive, provides residents with an easy way to donate food to those in need in the community.

Customers simply leave their donation of non-perishable goods next to their mailbox before the delivery of the mail on Saturday, May 13th. Letter carriers will collect these food donations on that day as they deliver mail along their postal routes and distribute them to local food agencies.

The Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive is the nation’s largest single-day food drive and is held annually on the second Saturday in May in 10,000 cities and towns in all 50 states. In 25 years, the Food Drive has collected more than 1.5 billion pounds of food.

With the economic struggles many Americans face, the Letter Carriers’ Food Drive is as critical as ever. Not only do millions of Americans go hungry, organizations that help them are in need of replenishment.

Hunger affects about 50 million people around the country, including millions of children, senior citizens and veterans. Pantry shelves filled up through winter-holiday generosity often are bare by late spring. And, with most school meal programs suspended during summer months,

Sabres Expected To Name New GM

Now that the Pegulas have named Brandon Beane as the new GM of their NFL football team, an announcement is expected soon as to the new GM of their NHL hockey team. Speculation has coalesced around reports from multiple sources that current Pittsburgh Penguins associate GM Jason Botterill has agreed to become the Sabres new general manager.

The delay in announcing this news is likely to prevent distractions while the Penguins are engaged in a dramatic playoff series against Washington culminating in a deciding game seven Wednesday May 10th (too late for the results to be reported here).

Botterill helped build the Penguins 2009 Stanley Cup champion team as the assistant GM and was the associate GM for last seasons 2016 Cup champs. His strength has been building the Pens from within and providing a pipeline for talent being promoted from their AHL team in Wilkes-Barre to the parent Penguins which was key for the Pens playoff success last season.

A former Sabres player who spent three years in the organization, Botterill played 36 games

for the Sabres in 2002-03 and 2003-04 before retiring in 2005. He was a standout playing for four years at the University of Michigan and was a first round pick of the Dallas Stars in 1994.

Botterill has a reputation as a smart cerebral person. His likely ascension to the GM position is part of a new trend in sports of getting away from promoting super scouts like Tim Murray into management. Now the thinking is lets groom our talent within

the management ranks by promoting them up the ladder which is the way most business organizations function.

The Penguins have groomed Botterill to take over from current GM Jim Rutherford but Rutherford at age 68 with his new Stanley Cup ring shows no sign that he's ready to step aside any time soon. Botterill at age 40 looks ready to assume more responsibility now rather than wait for a regime change within the Penguins organization.

Once Botterill assumes control in Buffalo, he is expected to name current assistant coach Rick Tocchet as the new head coach of the Sabres. While Tocchet's trunculent style of play has become passe in the modern game, perhaps he can light a fire under the Sabres players who need it.

across the street from the weekly market.

Musical entertainment returns each week from approximately 9:30 am to 12:30 pm, weather permitting. Highlighting the entertainment schedule will be two performances by the Buffalo Philharmonic String Quartet, at 10 am July 1st and July 29th.

Three community groups will also man informational tables at the market each week. Kid-Biz will bring its young entrepreneurs to the market on June 17th, July 8th and August. 5th, while the Wellness Institute of Greater Buffalo will host Wellness Lane events on July 15th and August 19th.

The Food Bank of Western New York's "Just Say Yes to Fruits and Vegetables!" program, a federally funded SNAP-Ed program available through New York State, will return to the market on May 27th. The goal of this obesity prevention nutrition education initiative is to promote fruit and vegetable consumption.

A Registered Dietitian will be present at the market to conduct nutrition workshops for the public and provide nutritious recipes involving fruits and vegetables for participants to sample. The weekly recipes will utilize local, seasonal produce, and participants will receive \$4 in "health bucks" which can be exchanged for produce from the farmers at the market. The program is free and open to any customers of the Elmwood Village Farmers Market.

Local artist Kristin Derby is a three-time winner of the market's annual poster competition. Her poster will be on display in stores and restaurants throughout the Elmwood Village and will also be featured on signage at the market. A limited number of posters will be available at the market and at the Elmwood Village Association office, free of charge, while supplies last.

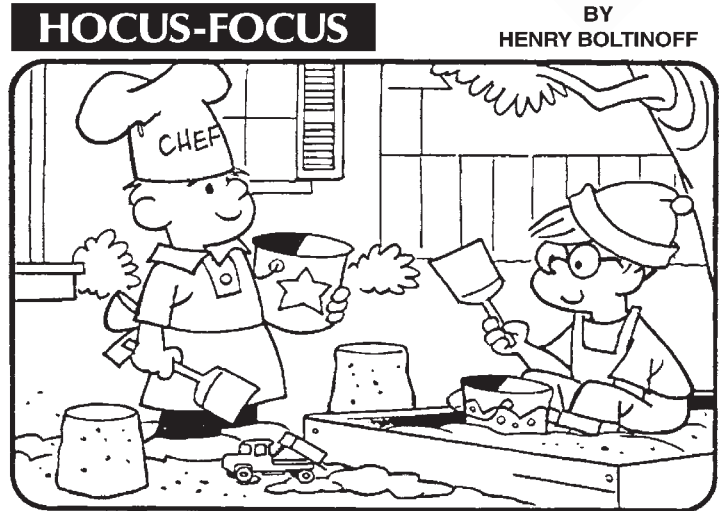
