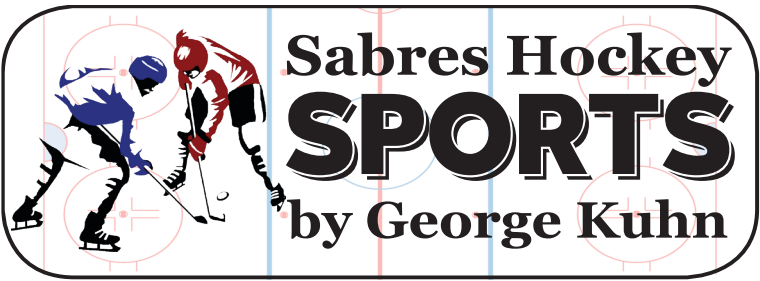

Sabres Coaching Candidates

Now that the Sabres have their new GM Jason Botterill in place, three top candidates have emerged for the coaching job.

Todd Rierden- was a journeyman defenseman who played professionally for 14 years with 18 different teams at every level including 183 NHL games. He has ties to Botterill from the Penguins organization where he was an assistant coach with the NHL Penguins from 2010-11 to 2013-14 and coached their AHL farm team in Wilkes Barre/Scranton from 2008-09 through 2009-10.

Rierden had been an assistant along with Tony Granato on Dan Bylsma’s staff with the Penguins and was let go along with Granato by Pittsburghs new GM Jim Rutherford on June 25th 2014, shortly after Bylsma had been terminated. Rierden was hired later that same day by the Washington Capitals as an assistant coach, where he remained through 2015-16, until promoted to associate coach this past season. Rierden is responsible for working with the Caps defensemen and power play. Rierden is reportedly interviewing for the Florida Panthers coaching job.

Rick Tocchet – is another candidate with Pittsburgh ties where he is currently as assistant coach with the Pens. Botterill has stated that communication is an important trait for his incoming coach. Tocchet’s visible on the bench video sessions with Penguins star Evgeni Malkin as an example of his abilities in that area. Malkin started slowly through the first game but following some intense video tablet sessions on the bench with Tocchet he scored and assisted on the only two Pittsburgh goals in the

first two games of their current series against Ottawa. However given Tocchets close relationship with Penguins owner Mario Lemieux, how interested is he in coming to Buffalo?

Phil Housley – the former Sabre would be a popular choice with the fans. Currently an assistant coach with the Nashville Predators, Housley coaches the Preds defensemen and is receiving a great deal of credit for the strong play of the Preds top four blueliners which has been key to Nashvilles playoff success. Housley was being considered for the Florida job but reportedly the Panthers are unwilling to wait for candidates whose teams are still in the playoffs. With puck moving defensemen vital to success today and given Buffalo’s profound weakness in that area, Housley could be the ideal addition for the Sabres.

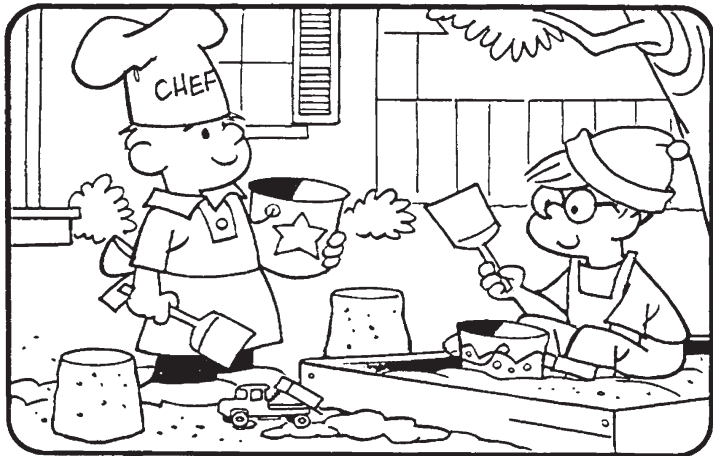

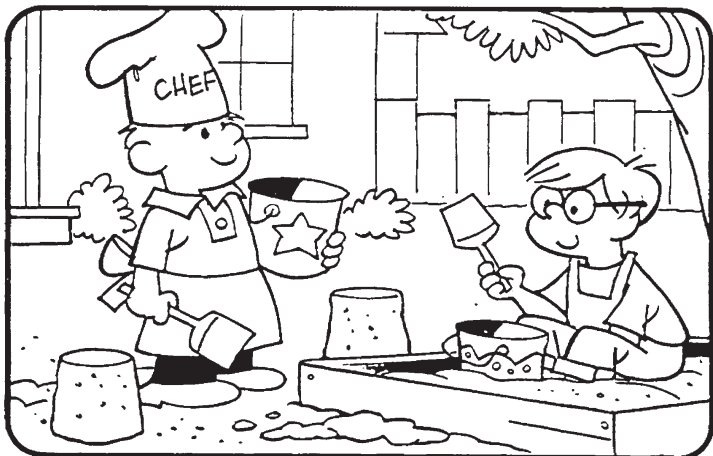

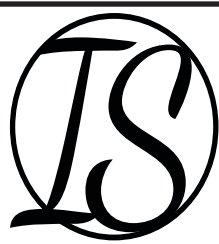
