Mayor Byron W. Brown rolled out a new City-wide mobile parking application, called "Buffalo Roam". Over the Memorial holiday weekend, city parking crews installed signs and decals on the sides of meters, listing new zone numbers, as part of a new custom city-wide mobile parking application.

The new signs and decals identify each of the designated parking blocks with a distinctive "Zone Number". Mayor Brown, the Buffalo Common Council and the City's Parking Department, worked closely with global parking app leader, Passport, to create "Buffalo Roam", a customized parking app specific to the Buffalo community. "We've launched a city-wide customized pay-by-app parking application to keep up with the increasing demand, further

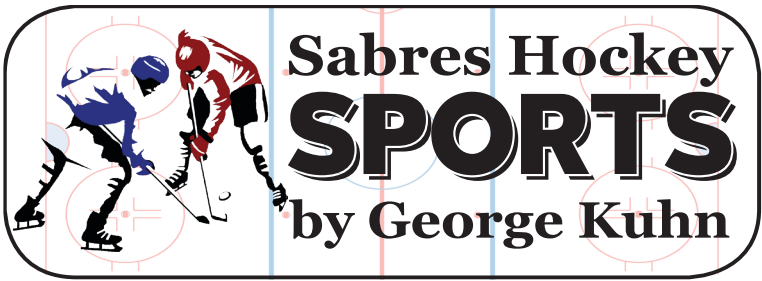

Sabres Begin Retool of Defense Corps

With the signing of Russian defenseman Viktor Antipin, the Buffalo Sabres have begun the long overdue retooling of their woeful defense corps. Last seasons group of defencemen were regarded by many observers as the weakest of any team in the NHL. The Sabres league worst 34.1 shots against per game would support that opinion.

Due to their slow foot speed defensemen like Cody Franson, Josh Gorges, Zach Bogosian and Carlo Colaiacovo were vulnerable to the dump and chase game. Far too often, the defense was unable to beat opposing forecheckers to loose pucks leading to an imbalance of puck possession time. Even when the defense was able to establish possession they were frequently unable to complete passes to the forwards.

Critics who have been quick to criticize management for not upgrading the defense perhaps do not understand that competent defenders with the skills to excel in today's fast paced NHL are prized possessions and not being traded away by their teams. These players must be drafted and developed within an organization.

Antipin is a significant acquisition for Buffalo. At age 24 he is experienced and not expected to need any development time in Rochester. He is a highly skilled skater and puck handler. "Victor is a well-rounded defenseman who has played in all situations at the pro level. His mobility and puck-moving skills make him a perfect match for what we're hoping to build with our defense corps next season," said Sabres GM Jason Botterill.

Playing in Russia's KHL with Metallurg Magnitogorsk the 5'11", 179 Lb. defenseman played 59 games last season scoring six goals and 24 points. Antipin has played for Metallurg for seven sea-

sons, registering 98 points in 266 regular season games and 37 points in 79 playoff games. He was named the best player of the IIHF World Championship matchup between Russia and the United States in which he played against Sabres star Jack Eichel along with NHL stars Johnny Gaudreau and Auston Matthews.

Antipin will join Brendan Guhle as newcomers with Buffalo and will both represent a major upgrade on the blueline for the 2017-18 season. Guhle is also a superb skater and puck-handler who finished last season in Rochester after his junior team in Prince George finished their season. At age 19 Guhle has already appeared in three games for Buffalo in 2016-17 and was definitely one of the best defensemen on the team in those games. Antipin and Guhle should eventually settle in as number two and three on the depth chart pushing Jake McCabe down to fourth.

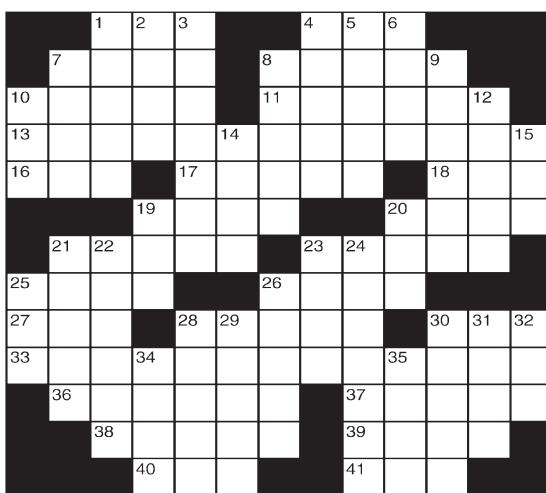
