


# Around North Buffalo

The self-guided tour begins in the heart of the Parkside community, outside of Hillside Children's Services at 70 Jewett Parkway at the corner of Jewett Parkway and Crescent Avenue, just a block from the Darwin Martin House complex. For those wishing to further explore this historic Frederick Law Olmsted-designed neighborhood, Explore Buffalo will be offering



guided walking tours at 9:30 am and 10:30 am highlighting architectural styles and elements interspersed with local Gilded Age residents' history and folklore. ## Pimento Cheese Spread Recipe

### Ingredients

- 3 oz cream cheese softened to room temp.
- 1/3 cup mayonnaise
- 1 tsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1 1/2 tsp apple cider vinegar
- 1/2 tsp hot sauce (optional)
- 1 tsp sugar
- 1 tsp dried mustard
- 1/2 tsp kosher salt
- 1/4 tsp freshly ground black pepper
- 1 4 oz jar diced pimiento drained well
- 1 1/2 cups shredded colby cheese
- 1 1/2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- Optional: 2 tbsp sliced green onion

### Instructions

In a medium bowl, combine

cream cheese, mayonnaise, Worcestershire sauce, apple cider vinegar, hot sauce, sugar, dried mustard, salt and pepper. Then stir in green onion (if using). Finally, stir in shredded cheese and drained pimientos until fully coated with mayon-

naise mixture. Cover with plastic wrap and put into the refrigerator to chill for at least 8 hours. This helps the flavors really come together. Then dig in! Serve on crackers or sandwiches or stir into grits (yum!)

**LOST STREAM MAP**

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK resembles another map--known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard Higbee's dream came true. Computers made it possible to reprint the map.

Then the STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW YORK was created.


