Eichel Ranked 14th Among NHL Centers

The NHL Network has re leased a ranking of the top 20 centers in the NHL Not surprisingly Connor McDavid is number one with Sydney Crosby number two. Jack Eichel is ranked number 14 which is sure to ruffle the feathers of Sabres fans. He does better ranking seventeenth overall on The Hockey News list of Top 200 Fantasy Players which includes all position players, not just centers. He drops a bit to 25th spot on their ranking of the top 50 NHL'ers.

Carrying the tag of "generational player" and being drafted behind wunderkind McDavid along with the Sabres investing two seasons of "tanking" has created huge and unrealistic expectations for Jack among Sabres fans. His 56 point rookie season was rather average for a 2nd overall pick. While he played for a weak team with little help, other highly touted players had outstanding rookie seasons with weak teams like Sydney Crosby with 102 points and Alexander Ovechkin with 52 goals and 106 points.

Some strong play in 2016-17 after returning

from his ankle injury saw Eichel go on a two month hot streak in February and March where he scored at a 98 point pace before tailing off at the end of the season. He finished with 24 goals and 57 points in 61 games.

For those who enjoy watching the smooth skating Eichel carry the

puck, take note that he led the NHL with six possessions per game carrying the puck out of his own zone and also with 8 possessions per game entering the attacking zone. As such a compelling argument could be made that no player is more important to their team than Eichel.

With the roster upgrades on defense the Sabres are expected to move up a contend for a playoff position in 2017-18. A big season from Eichel will help the cause and he should be able to generate 80-85 points or more if he stays health for 80 or so games.




