In observance of the 16th anniversary of the 9/11 terrorist attacks, nearly 3,000 flags-- one for each of the victims who lost their lives—have been placed on the front lawn of the American Red Cross Western New York Chapter headquarters, 786 Delaware Avenue.

“My reading program called READ 83 has really taken off and will support Boys & Girls Clubs in NFL cities,” Reed said. “I was a club kid who made it into the Pro Football Hall of Fame. Now I represent what they stand for and I know that through reading, every child can do the same. Reading is a way out!” Team Read 83 is also excited to introduce this new collaboration with inner city literacy experts from iKnowABC. In partnership with the Andre Reed Foundation, Pro Athlete Community Engagement Manager Theresa Villano and Cindy

Finelli Coleman, M.Ed., of Cindy and Co., have co-created the Read with Reed 83 program. ## Stuffed Tomato Recipe

### Ingredients

4 beefsteak or heirloom tomatoes  
Salt and pepper  
1 1/2 cups (4 ounces) shredded Pepper Jack cheese  
1 large clove garlic, finely chopped  
3 tablespoons grated or finely chopped white onion  
1 cup whole wheat panko breadcrumbs  
1 teaspoon dried oregano  
A handful cilantro or parsley, finely chopped  
1/4 cup grated Parm cheese  
Olive oil spray

### Preparation

Cut the tops off the toma-

atoes and lightly give them with a gentle squish or use a teaspoon to remove some seeds. Carefully scoop the flesh into a bowl and season the hulled tomatoes with salt and pepper. Combine the flesh with Pepper Jack, garlic and onion; re-stuff the tomatoes.

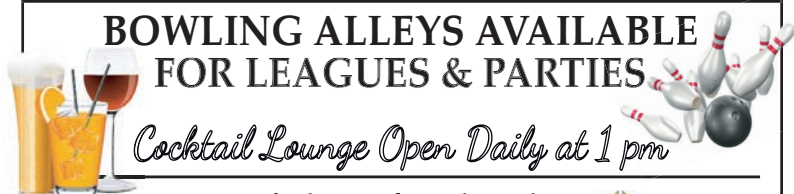
