## Be Careful Who You Give To

Attorney General Eric T. Schneiderman issued an alert reminding New Yorkers to consider consulting the office’s charitable giving tips before making a donation to support organizations assisting the victims of Hurricane Irma and Hurricane Harvey. Reports following Hurricane Harvey indicate that some scammers were using links to purported charitable organizations as a phishing attempt to steal personal information from

those seeking to make a donation. Scammers have already attempted to set up fake GoFundMe campaigns soliciting donations for Hurricane Irma.

“Unfortunately, natural disasters can bring out the most shameless scammers. We’ve seen troubling reports of cyber criminals and fraudsters looking to exploit individuals who are simply trying to help those in need,” said the Attorney General. “Please remain vigilant before donating to

any fundraising appeal or clicking on any links supposedly associated with charities, and I urge New Yorkers to follow our tips so they can protect themselves and guarantee their generosity will help the many victims of these devastating storms.”

The following tips are offered for those contributing to the relief effort: Take Time To Research The Organization. Make sure you are familiar with the organization, its mission,

and its effectiveness before giving. Always ask for information in writing – be wary if an organization will not provide information about charitable programs and finances upon request. Any legitimate organization will be happy to send you information. Check the Attorney General’s website – [www.charitiesnys.com](http://www.charitiesnys.com) – to ensure that it is registered, and to learn more about its mission and finances.






Know Where Your Mon-

ey Will Go. Find out from the charity what it will do with your money. Any legitimate organization will be glad to send you this information.

Give to Established Charities. Donate to organizations you are familiar with, or have an experience assisting in disaster relief. Get information about charities that pop up solely in response to the hurricane or those with unfamiliar names.

# Awards End HNPYBL Season

The 2017 Hertel North Park Youth Baseball and Softball League season quietly came to an end last Friday night September 8th in an Amherst banquet hall filled with hundreds of boys and girls, all winners out on the diamonds of Shoshone Park. According to League president Don Morris, this season was very successful for the 61 year old league with enrollment numbering close to 1,000 players.

Competition in our house league was very high. Travel teams did well representing our League with victories and good play. Our Wildcat Girls Softball Tournament in its 14th season, numbered 28 teams, their biggest since it began play in Shoshone and Hertel

North Park retained the Buffalo Cup for the ninth time in 10 years.

But Morris was very upfront with everyone in the room, saying all this could not be possible without the help of parents, who bring the players to the Park on a regular basis for games, practices or team meetings throughout the Summer. Some serve as team managers and coaches in the various levels, volunteering their time to teach youngsters how to swing a bat, throw a pitch or catch a fly ball. He also extended a big thank you to his team of volunteers that serve with him on the board of directors.

Eleven teams were honored this night, everyone from Shamrock Girls in Rookie to grown young Boys in the Seniors. Much has been written previously about a teams' season, but an event like this

connected the winners with the beautiful gold and shiny trophies handed out to everyone this night. There's probably a shelf or bedroom dresser just waiting to hold a token of a winning season.

While most coaches quickly summarized their season in a few sentences and introduced their players, a few expressed the emotional attachment they acquire while teaching boys or girls the game they themselves grew up playing as well. These are the best moments of Hertel North Park because everyone becomes a part of an extended family in the North Buffalo community.

The Shamrocks won the Championship in Rookie girls with two big wins over the Diamonds by a 9-2 score in both games. Peyton Gallivan was a spark plug at the plate and led teammates like Claire McGillicuddy, Skyler Ball, Isabella Kilonsky, and cousins Ally and Lydia Foglia to victory that ended a super season. "The girls all played great," said Betsy Foglia, the Shamrock manager. "Everyone contributed and learned how to hit the ball and play together on the diamond. It was a lot of fun."

This was the first season for Foglia, leading a team as a coach. After losing just one game during the regular season, the Shamrocks quickly lost their first game to the Diamonds, 10-9 in the double elimination playoffs.

They bounced back however, with wins over the Angels and Lil Devils before the rematch games with the Diamonds. Other girls on the team included Sarah Clark,

Mi' Ajah Clyburn, MacKenzie Gunnarson, Jordyn and Mia Harris, Nakiyah McCready and Skylar Wintringer.

The Twins won the Championship in First Minor boys with a close, 7-6 win over the Tigers after the team had lost to Detroit just a week earlier, 5-2. In a battle of two good teams, the Twins had the better record during the season but faced a hot Tigers team that came running for bear. Joey Cheman, Kendrick Rosario, Mariano Nati and Giovanni Amodeo led the Tigers all season long with excellent pitching on the mound and good defense around the diamond but Minnesota was just too much the second time.


Players like Jeremiah Williams, Kamron Lattimore, Joseph Ward and Keir Bishop formed an awesome infield for pitchers James and Sammy Gallivan, actual Twin brothers with gun-like arms from the mound. The Twins had only one loss during the year until the playoffs and

were resilient all season long. Other players include Dominic Digesare, Tremayne Harris, Robert Johnson, Brody Marino, George Richardson and Jack Schoellkopf. Manager Ryan Gallivan stepped back into a dugout for the first time in several years and made up for lost time.

The Senior girls Pirates and Senior boys Dodgers teams were introduced later this night, led by their team managers Kelly Kilonsky and Paul Fuzak, respectively. These two divisions don't begin play until the Memorial Day weekend, but great baseball and softball takes place on diamonds two and five late every summer. Katarina

Sako, Mia Trietley and Philomena Vennari helped lead the Pirates in this their last season in Shoshone Park. Max Schmarder, Santino Hernandez, Santo Sonnett and D'Andre Huynh were just four of the "dynamic Dodgers" who won their second, consecutive team Championship in a row, this time defeating the Orioles. Brothers Jon and Sam Chapman led the way but were helped out by newcomers Matt Becker, Steve Purpora, Joe Persico and Dylan Speck.

Don Morris, the leagues' president summed up the whole evening by exclaiming to all that next Spring will be here soon.







Be Cautious With Telephone Solicitations. Telephone calls asking for donations to charity are often made by a professional fundraiser who is required to register with the Charities Bureau. Remember – you can always hang up. If you choose not to end the call, ask whether the telemarketer is registered and how much of your donation will go to charity and how much the telemarketer is being paid. Many telemarketers receive most of the money they raise. Giving directly to a charity avoids those costs.

Check Before You Text A Contribution. Check the charity's website or call the charity to confirm it has authorized contributions to be made via text message. One

thing to keep in mind is that donations via text messaging may not reach the charity until after your phone bill is paid. It may be faster to contribute directly to the charity.

Check Before Donating to an Online Giving Site. Make sure your contribution to campaigns set up by individuals on sites such as GoFundMe or CrowdRise will go to charity and not to the person raising the funds. Don't contribute unless you know that person.

Don't Respond to Unsolicited Spam Emails. These formats are usually not associated with legitimate charities. Check the Department of Homeland Security's tips, such as Avoiding Social Engineering and Phishing Attacks that are posted at <http://www.us-cert.gov/ncas/tips/ST04-014>.

Never Give Cash. Give your contribution by credit card or a check made payable to the charity.

Be Careful About Personal Information. Avoid giving credit card or personal information over the phone or by text message. In all cases, make sure you are familiar with the organization and check to see that the fundraising campaign is legitimate before donating.

Report Suspicious Organizations. If you believe an organization is misrepresenting its work, or that a scam is taking place, please contact the Attorney General's Charities Bureau at [charities.complaints@ag.NY.gov](mailto:charities.complaints@ag.NY.gov) or 212-416-8401.


