It is even more limited when a teenager shows interest and potential excellence in the field of life sciences

Eichel Shines While Sabres Stumble

This was the season that Jack Eichel was expected to blossom and with two goals and nine points in seven games so far he hasn't disappointed. With his powerful wrist shot the goals are not forthcoming because he simply doesn't shoot enough. League leading goal scorer Alex Ovechkin has 39 shots and nine goals for a 23.1 % shooting percentage. Teammate Evander Kane also has 39 shots with five goals and ten points to lead the team in scoring. Nikita Kucherov of Tampa Bay leads the league with a 29.3 shooting percentage with eight goals on 27 shots. The inference is clear, shoot more and score

Eichel's play making has been exemplary with some spectacular primary assists. It's early in the season but his nine points in seven games project to a 105 point season - that's scoring title contention - and he really hasn't gone on a hot streak yet. Eichel's defensive play is improving with a strong effort on back checking using his speed to catch opponents and lift their sticks to disrupt the attack. And he is assuming more of a leadership role calling out his team for not caring enough about winning. Coupled with recent comments from Marcus Foligno about the organization not pushing the players enough to be winners it paints a disturbing picture.

The team around him has been a disappointment with only one win in their first seven games. Other than Kane (5-5-10) and Jason Pominville (4-5-9) every player on the team has underachieved so far.

While Robin Lehner still can't stop a shootout attempt, his teammates also can't score on one. Even Jack Eichel is only 1 for 12 on shootouts and isn't even used as a primary shooter. The Sabres only scored two shootout goals all last season, Lehner says his shootout problems are strictly mental. Imagine being in his shoes (or skates) and your teammates can't score so you have to stop every shot and hope for the best, how would you deal with that?

Defenseman Rasmus Ristolainen seems to be regressing. Veterans Ryan O'Reilly and Kyle Okposo have been noticeably absent from the score sheet, Even though O'Reilly had a pair of goals against Las Vegas in an Oct. 17th loss he said they came at the expense of his defensive game as reflected in his -2 rating on the night.

The team continues to deliver uninspired performances and players talk about how they aren't prepared to start the games. These are the same complaints from last year when coach Dan Bylsma took the fall. The Sabres now we have a new coach and ten new players but the same problems. It looks like GM Jason Botterill needs to swap out a few more play-

may show the most promise for them.

Once again, thanks to a generous grant from the Cullen Foundation one of the Buffalo Zoo's newest tools will be available to complement traditional career counseling. The grant has allowed for the development of an innovative experiential learning program for teenagers (ages 14-18) who show an interest in careers in life science. The Life Science Career Lab program gives

teens the chance to try on at least six different life science career hats to see if any of them fit. Excited by this offering, Buffalo Zoo Curator of Education Tiffany Vanderwerf stated that "teens today need every bit of help in defining their potential career path, so we are thrilled that we have the chance to work with this age group again in 2018 to explore their options in this field; a field near and dear to our hearts."

The Zoo's mission includes

educating the public and professionals alike in the topics of threatened and endangered species, habitat conservation, and the overall puzzle of how each component in the environment is directly linked to one another. To this point, Vanderwerf adds "science isn't just about putting on a lab coat and looking under a microscope. While that can be fun for some. science can also be about getting outdoors to figure

out how to save plants and animals from extinction, caring for the health of humans and animals, or managing the use of land resources." This new and unique program will take a hands-on approach career exploration. Eight weeks in duration and running on Saturday mornings, the program culminates with an event at the Zoo for students to showcase their efforts to family, educators, and

friends. Not only that, students will be rewarded for their efforts if completing the program in its entirety, with a \$250.00 Visa gift card. The program will offer a limited class size, with some eligibility requirements. Additional information, along with the formal application is available on the Zoo's web site, www.buffalozoo.org. The application deadline is Monday, December 4, 2017.
