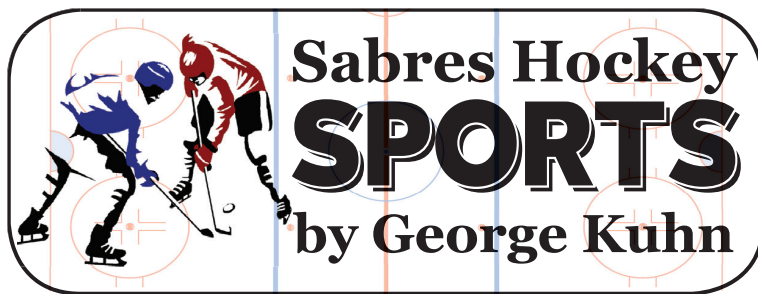

Rasmus Ristolainen and Sabres Defenders: No Goals Through 12 Games

After going winless in their first five games, the Sabres have quietly played .500 hockey going 6-6-2 since winning their first game in Anaheim 3-1 on October 15th. The most significant game in this modest streak was a 5-4 overtime win at Boston on October 21st where Buffalo overcame a 4-1 deficit with a third period rally to tie the score at 4-4 and send the game to overtime where they dominated the Bruins to get the win.

They followed up with a 1-0 home ice victory over the slumping Detroit Red Wings on October 24th only to get throttled in Columbus 5-1. They closed out the week at home with a well played game against the San Jose Sharks where they played well but lost 3-2 when goalie Robin Lehner surrendered a late goal on a shot that he should have stopped.

So the Sabres are essentially a .500 team with their record weighted down by their 0-4-1 start. To be polite, the team was ineffective in the first two weeks making bad decisions and surrendering so many two on one breaks that their goaltenders could have sued for non support. They resembled a youth team that hasn't learned how to play positions yet.

It seemed clear that the

team was having difficulty implementing new coach Phil Housley's offensive puck possession system. While he was lauded for molding a mobile skilled attacking group of defenders with Nashville, Housley had some high end talent to work with in the music city. In Buffalo his group of defensemen do not exhibit the same skill set.

Through the first 12 games of the season, the defense corps has not produced a single goal. The leading scorer among defensemen is Rasmus Ristolainen with four assists in 12 games. His frequent partner on the top pair, Marco Scandella, has two assists. The combined scoring totals of Buffalo's group of defensemen is 12 assists in 12 games, or the same number of points as leading scorer Jason Pominville.

While improving the teams puck possession with a skilled puck moving defense corps is a good plan, the question is whether the Sabres have the personnel to make it happen. Ristolainen has regressed so far this season and no longer shows potential to be a dominant top pair defenseman. Last season he produced six goals and 45 points, 25 of which (56%) came on the power play. This season he projects to 27 points over the full schedule.

Scandella has scored only seven goals in his last 177 NHL games. While he did have 11 goals in 2014-15, that was a one off season. While he does have a strong shot, he is not a naturally gifted offensive style player. Remember that he was unable to crack the top four with Minnesota where he was the number five defenseman. Although he does make the team better, expecting big things from him as a top pair defenseman is a bit of a stretch. While it's a bit early to judge, the lack of scoring from the blueliners hints at the challenges faced by coach Phil Housley implementing his system. Give it 30 games and we can formulate a more realistic assessment.
