Don't Be A Turkey When It Comes To Food Safety!

As planning for the rapidly between 40°F and Thanksgiving meal accelerates, it is time to take a moment to review the safest methods to thaw, prepare, stuff, and cook your turkey.

"The first rule to follow is that it is essential to thaw turkeys at a safe temperature. Foodborne bacteria multiply

140°F. A frozen turkey may be safe indefinitely, but as soon as it begins to thaw, bacteria that may have been present before its freezing can begin to grow again." states Dr. Gale Burstein, Erie County Commissioner of Health. "Thaw turkeys safely in one of three

ways: in a refrigerator, in cold water that is changed every 30 minutes, or in a microwave oven."

Proper preparation demands cleanliness at all stages. Bacteria on raw poultry can contaminate hands, utensils, other foods and work Continued on page four.

Only Two Players Have More Shots Than Evander Kane

1 The Sabres dropped their sixth straight game 3-2 to the Columbus Bluejackets Monday night at Key Bank Arena. After being outplayed during the first two periods, two scores late in the third by Sam Reinhart (his 4th) and Evander Kane (his team leading 12th) closed the gap to 3-2 and brought some life into a sparsely populated arena. Despite a replay showing the puck moving across the goal line before being obscured by falling bodies, the ruling was the referee had blown his whistle to stop the play. Even so the Columbus coach John Totarella was ready to challenge the goal on the basis of goalie interference and it appeared that he had some basis for that objection.

2. The Sabres demonstrated that playing well for ten minutes is not enough to win in the NHL. A strong finish to the game was insufficient to overcome the 3-0 lead the Bluejackets built over 50 minutes. At one point in the first period Columbus was ahead 10-5 in shots which was a fair reflection of the play. Buffalo took the play to Columbus in the third period out shooting them 15-5 to finish ahead 32-29 for the game.

3. Coach Phil Housley stated after the game that the reason Evander Kane keeps scoring is that he shoots the puck. Kane leads

the team with 96 shots in 21 games or 4.6 per game. He is third the league behind only Alex Ovechkin (101) and Max Pacioretty (98). Jack Eichel is second on the team with 67 shots ranking 19th in the league. Ryan O'Reilly is third with 54 shots. With only one goal in six of their last ten games before playing Columbus, the Sabres are desperate for goals. To win in the present day NHL you need to be able to consistently score three goals or better every game.

The Sabres have scored once in seven games and their record in those games is 1-6. With two goals scored their record is 0-7. When scoring three goals, their record is 2-1. When scoring four times their record is 0-2 with a loser point in both games. When scoring five times they are 2-0. When scoring three or more goals, the Sabres have a 4-1-2 record. It looks like coach Housley is right, if you score more you win more.

Maybe Evander Kane can tutor some of his teammates on how to get more shots on goal. But he can't teach effort. Kane in consistently the hardest working playing on the team game after game. That's why he is successful getting shots on goal. If only effort was contagious. This group of players seems largely immune to hard work.

4. With the loss the Sabres now have a season record of 5-12-4 for 14 points. Let's face facts, that means five wins and 16 losses with four "loser points" for an overtime loss. Their 14 points are the second lowest total in the league ahead of only the woeful Arizone Coyotes with 13. While the desert dogs have had exclusive hold on last place for weeks, they are now on a three game winning streak and defeated Toronto 4-1 while the Sabres were losing to Columbus. The 'Yotes record is now 5-13-3. An Arizona win against San Jose on Wednesday Nov 22nd coupled with a Sabres loss to Minnesota that night will put the Sabres in last place in the entire league. While I like to think that 30 games are needed to get a good idea of how a team stacks up over the long NHL season, after 21 games it looks like the Sabres should be in a full blown rebuild mode.

5. Jack Eichel picked up an assist against Columbus giving him 17 points in 21 games on five goals and 12 assists. This projects to 20 goals and 46 assists for the season. He currently ranks 62nd in NHL scoring and is in the midst of a month long scoring slump with only one goal and five assists for six points in his last 12 games. These are hardly the numbers of a franchise player let alone a presumed generational talent. While he played well against Columbus he has not been noticeable in some games. He has failed to register a single point seven times in his last 12 games. Most nights he plays well briefly and then disappears, almost like he's disinterested



Food Safety Preparations

surfaces during holiday dinner preparation. If work areas are not cleaned thoroughly after preparing the turkey and before working with other foods, bacteria from raw poultry can contaminate other foods. Poultry may contain harmful bacteria such as Salmonella, Listeria, and Campylobacter that can cause infectious diarrhea and more serious complications. "After working with any raw poultry, always wash your hands, utensils, and work surfaces thoroughly before touching other foods." continues Dr. Burstein.

Set the oven cooking temperature no lower than 325°F. Once the turkey is ready for the oven, it is essential that the turkey reaches an internal minimum temperature of 165°F. Stuffing inside a turkey should also be cooked to at least 165°F. As is always true, ensure safety of all foods by keeping the hot foods hot and the cold foods cold.

The best part of a holiday meal is often leftovers! One of the biggest food safety mistakes is leaving food out at room temperature. To keep them safe, refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours of preparation. Food that sits out for more than 2 hours in the "danger zone", which is above 40°F and below 140°F, risks the growth of bacteria. Store leftovers in 2-inch deep, shallow containers for efficient cooling. Make sure the refrigerator is not over-packed, so that there is plenty of room for cold air to circulate.

Reheating a plate of food in the microwave for a few minutes may seem safe enough. When reheating leftovers, ensure they reach a temperature of 165°F, using a thermometer to ensure all food on the plate is reheated sufficiently to kill any bacteria. Since microwaves heat in an uneven manner and vary in power levels, let reheated and covered food sit covered for 1-2 minutes to allow the heat to further penetrate the food and destroy bacteria that may have been present.
