## Five thoughts about the Buffalo Sabres

1. Following a 3-1 home ice victory against Connor McDavid and the Edmonton Oilers, the Sabres promptly dropped their next two games without even scoring a goal and have only one win in their last ten games with a 3-0 loss on the road at Montreal on Saturday Nov. 26th followed by a 2-0 loss to the league leading Tampa Bay Lightning on Tuesday Nov. 28th. Right now Tampa Bay is the leading candidate for the 2018 Stanley Cup championship. That would make two Cup wins for the 1992 expansion team under two different ownership and management groups. Their success has been predicated on drafting well, an area where the Sabres have not excelled in recent years.

Following their 2004 Stanley Cup, Tampa finished last in the 2007-08 season. Their prize was winning the draft lottery and selecting Steven Stamkos first overall in the 2008 entry draft. Stamkos has lived up to his billing and is currently the NHL's leading scorer with 10 goals and 36 points.

Following back to back last place finishes Buffalo lost both draft lottery's but were fortunate that Jack Eichel was available as a consolation prize in 2015. Eichel currently sits 69th in league scoring with seven goals and 19 points in 25 games. The cream usually rises to the top in the entry draft as Stamkos, a number

one pick and Connor McDavid, the one who got away, continue to demonstrate. While Eichel is an elite player, he has not played at the level of Stamkos or McDavid.

2. Tampa scored big in the 2009 entry draft selecting Victor Hedman 2nd overall behind John Tavares. This was the draft where Evander Kane was pick 4th by the Atlanta Thrashers. Hedman and Tyler Myers were both rookies in the 2009-10 season. At age 18 Hedman struggled while the 19 year old Myers wowed the league with his skating skill and huge frame winning the Calder Trophy as rookie of the year. Myers looked like a major coup for GM Darcy Regier who traded up to pick him 12th overall in 2008. But Myers regressed in Buffalo while Hedman developed into a major star and perennial Norris Trophy candidate. This shouldn't surprise anyone where Hedman - a number 2 pick outshines Myers - a 12th pick because the cream usually rises to the top in the entry draft.

3. Tampa Bay's first goal was scored on a point shot by Mikhail Segachev who was drafted 9th overall by Montreal in 2016, one spot behind Buffalo who selected Alex Nylander. While the Nylander selection was hailed as a smart choice for a team needing scoring, he has struggled with the pro game and scored only 10 goals for Rochester last year.

Segachev was acquired by Tampa from Montreal for Jonathan Drouin. Segachev has

been a star so far with six goals and 16 points in 24 games, almost equal to Jack Eichel's 19 points. Sergachev's six goals are six more than the entire defense corps have scored this season. That's how you build an elite NHL defense, by drafting and developing your players. Not by acquiring other teams cast offs like the 30th place Sabres do.

4. Defenseman Viktor Antipin has really come along since being a healthy scratch for several games. His skating and puck skills are at an elite level and his retrievals and outlet passes have been superb in recent games. This is what the Sabres hoped they were getting from him and the returns are good at this point. With Rasmus Ristolainen, Marco Sacandella and the developing Brenad Guhle, the Sabres have a decent top four of NHL caliber defenders although none of them are standouts for the first pair.

5. Marco Scandella commented after the game that the team needs to find a way to play with more pride. Fans wonder why the Sabres don't play with desperation. If they could play better they would already be doing it. In today's fast paced NHL, only Eichel, Antipin, Evander Kane, Rasmus Ristolainen and Brendan Guhle, currently playing in Rochester, have the skills to excel. Ryan O'Reilly is effective but layers like Jason Pominville and Kyle Okposo are losing ground in a league where the pace of the play gets faster every day. After 25 game, it's safe to say that this team is playing to it's capabilities as they sit tied with Arizona in 30th place.

The team has prospects coming up, like Guhle who will make a difference at the NHL level. Drafting and developing their talent will move the Sabres forward. A number one or two pick this year is not an organizational goal like in the tank years but it will help the cause.

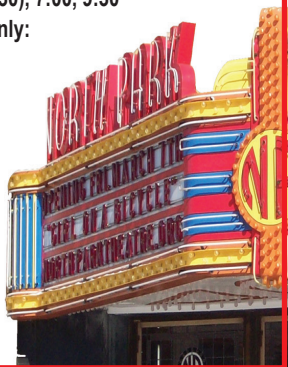

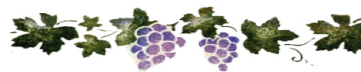

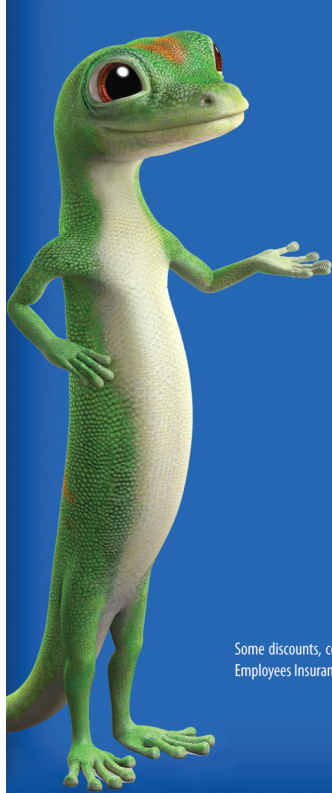

## BUFFALO'S Best RECIPES

### Turkey Stew



#### Ingredients

1 chicken bouillon cube  
1 c hot water  
2 c cooked turkey, cubed  
1 large turkey bone (preferably with a little turkey meat remaining)  
2 large carrots, cut into 1/2-inch pieces  
4 stalks celery, cut into 1/2-inch pieces  
1 small onion, chopped  
1 large tomato, chopped  
3 Tbsp all-purpose flour  
1/2 c uncooked white rice (see note below)  
1/2 c uncooked wild rice (see note below)  
2 tsp dried parsley

2 tsp dried oregano

4 c water  
1/2 tsp salt, or to taste  
1/2 tsp black pepper, or to taste

#### Directions

Dissolve the bouillon in the hot water to make a broth; set aside.

Preheat broiler. Place turkey bone on broiler pan, and place under preheated broiler for 10 minutes, to enhance the flavoring a bit.

Place the turkey meat, turkey bone, all the vegetables, flour, both kinds

of rice (or egg noodles), spices, chicken broth and water in a large kettle or Dutch oven. Season with salt and pepper, and stir well.

Bring the soup to a boil. Then simmer over low heat for 30 to 45 minutes, or until the carrots and celery are tender, stirring frequently.

**NOTE:** You can replace both the white rice and wild rice with 1 cup egg noodles (or other pasta) if you wish.

Remove turkey bone and serve immediately.

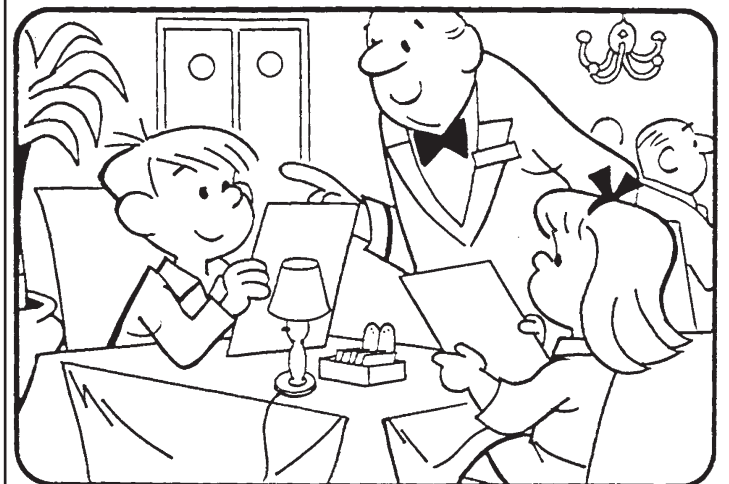

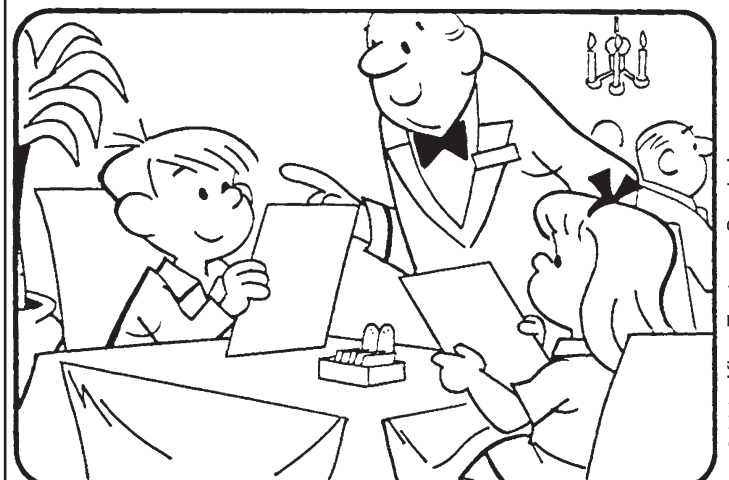
