#### **Five Thoughts About The Sabres**

1. The Sabres have quietly put together a four game point streak (2-0-2) starting with last weeks 4-2 win in Denver against the Rockies. Then the Sabres went to overtime, earning loser points on the road in a pair of 3-2 OT losses against the Chicago Blackhawks and St Louis Blues. But let's not kid ourselves, the Sabres had their helmets handed to them in both of those overtime losses where the combined shots on goal were 95-52 against. Only Robin Lehner, Evan Rodrigues' two goals against St. Louis and Lady Luck kept the Sabres in those games. Lehner faced 52 shots in Chicago and lost the game in overtime on a last second shot. On social media some fans mocked him some saying that he lost on purpose to avoid going to a shootout where he has been dreadful allowing everv shooter to score. In reality the team didn't deserve a point in either game and can thank their goaltender for those two points.

2. Rodrigues two goals in the 2-2 tie against the Blues gave him three points (2-1-3) in his first three games of his injury delayed season and a plus two on a roster loaded with minus players. When the Sabres signed Rodrigues as an undrafted free agent in 2015, it looked like they wanted him around to help his college linemate, Jack Eichel, feel more comfortable

signing with Buffalo when there was some speculation that he would return to Boston University for a second season.

While Eichel was a rookie with Buffalo in 2015-16, Rodrigues was down in Rochester learning the pro game with nine goals in 78 games. Last season, Rodrigues scored nine goals and 30 points in Rochester but in only 48 games while spending 30 games with Buffalo scoring four times. His addition to the lineup has helped provide a spark for the bottom dwelling Sabres. It looks like he has found a home in Buffalo while more highly touted prospects like Justin Bailey and Nick Baptiste continue their development in Rochester where they are both in their third season. Bailey has four goals in 47 NHL games and 45 goals in 126 AHL games. Baptiste has three goals in 18 NHL games and 42 goals in 139 AHL games.

3. The Sabres gave the home fans a holiday treat on Tuesday December 12th with a 3-2 victory over the struggling Ottawa Senators in a battle to avoid last place in the East. The offensive output was an explosion of goals for the offensively challenged Sabres. Goalie Robin Lehner faced only 26 shots enjoyed

a relatively easy night compared to the barrage of rubber he saw on the road trip last week. Lehner improved his record against the Senators, his old team, to 5-0-2 with a .935 save percentage and a 1.39 GAA. The win gave Buffalo 22 points, three behind Ottawa in their battle to avoid the basement of the Eastern Conference.

4. Tuesday's victory over Ottawa saw offensive contribution from the teams best players with Kyle Okposo scoring after a brilliant backhand pass from Ryan O'Reilly through a small forest of legs and sticks right on the tape. Rasmus Ristolainen had two assists including the primary assist setting up Evander Kane's powerplay goal giving Buffalo a 3-0 lead. Jack Eichel had a secondary assist on the Kane goal.

5. Eichel now has 24 points on the season with eight goals, projecting out to 21 goals and 63 points over the full 82 game schedule. This was Eichels third power play point, all assists. He has not scored a power play goal this season. This is a far cry from 2016-17 when he scored 10 goals and 14 assists with the man advantage in only 61 games.

He ranks 53rd in league scoring while Connor Mc-David, his supposed rival as a generational player, has climbed to 3rd place with 39 points, three behind Steven Stamkos and Nikita Kucherov of the Tampa Bay Lightning who are tied for the scoring lead with 42 points. The cream always rises to the top.
