Jazz Series Presents Monty Alexander

The 2017-2018 Art of Jazz Series will present legendary jazz pianist Monty Alexander with his trio at the Albright-Knox Art Gallery on Sunday, January 28th, at 3 pm. Series producer Bruce Eaton will host a pre-concert discussion, "The Importance of Ernest Ranglin," about the seminal Jamaican jazz and reggae guitarist, at 2 pm.

More than fifty-five years after moving to the US from his hometown of Kingston, Jamaica, Alexander is an American classic, touring the world relentlessly and delighting a global audience drawn to his vibrant personality and soulful message. Cited as the fifth-greatest jazz pianist ever in The Fifty Greatest Jazz Piano Players of All Time (Hal Leonard Publishing), his career as a leader is highlighted by more than seventy recordings, as well as work with artists including Frank Sinatra, Dizzy Gillespie, Tony Bennett, Sonny Rollins, Clark Terry, Ray Brown, and Quincy

Now entering its eighteenth season as the most successful music series of its kind in Western New York history, the Art of Jazz has established the Albright-Knox Auditorium as one of the premier venues to experience live jazz in North America. 2017-2018 series will continue with the Billy Childs Quartet (3/18/18), and the Melissa Aldana Quartet (4/21/18).

Free Rabies Vaccination Clinics

The first of six free rabies vaccination clinics provided by the Erie County Department of Health will be on Wednesday, January 24th. The clinic will be held from 3 pm - 7 pm at the North Buffalo Community Center at 203 Sanders Road in North Buffalo. "In 2017, 1,129 cats, 3,335 dogs and 32 ferrets (total =

4,496) were **Erie County** vaccinated Department of countywide Health through these clinics. said Po-

loncarz. I strongly encourage pet owners around the County to take advantage of this valuable and mandated public health initiative."

Commissioner of Health Dr. Gale Burstein added "We are pleased to continue working with our long-time rabies clinic partners. The invaluable assistance of the Niagara Frontier Veterinary Society, the SPCA serving Erie County, the veterinary

technology program at Medaille College, and volunteers from Erie County's Specialized Medical Assistance Response Team truly help us provide this vital and popular service to our community."

Any pet is at risk of being exposed to a rabid wild animal and rabies is always

fatal in animals. Bats often find their way into homes, Public Health especially while seek-

ing warmth in the winter. To date, ECDOH has identified 15 animals (bats, raccoons, skunk, sheep) that tested positive for rabies in 2017.

Senior Public Health Sanitarian, Peter Tripi added "Our goal is to have 100% of Erie County pets vaccinated to protect them from rabies. It is important that both "indoor" and "outdoor" cats receive vaccinations as a rabid Continued on page five.

Why Not Play Defense?

The Sabres moribund offense showed some life during a 7-4 home ice loss to the Winnipeg Jets as Jack Eichel, Ryan O'Reilly and Kyle Okposo each tallied three points. However, following the game coach Phil Housley called out his team saying that some players are cheating on defense so they can get their points.

"There's a lot of cheat in our game, I think they think that points are more important than playing solid defense and you can see the results that are coming," Housley said following the game. Buffalo has given up three goals or more goals in eight straight contests, winning just once in that span.

So who was Housley referring to? The aforementioned Eichel has been on a hot streak scoring 10 goals and 17 points in his last 11 games and now sits 28th in league scoring. Eichel's even strength scoring has been particularly noteworthy with 17 goals, the NHL's sixth best total. His 33 even strength points are seventh best. But Eichel is also a minus 13 so he is actually a liability at five on five.

Eichel is particularly inattentive defensively when the opposition has puck possession in the Sabres zone. In one recent game he was trapped for 1:45 without being able to clear the puck. A typical shift lasts no longer

than 40 seconds so that is a long time to be on the ice where chasing the opposition tires a player out fast.

The modern NHL is a defense first league where shot blocking is a skill as important as skating. It was interesting to see Steven Stamkos of the Tampa Bay Lightning hustle on the back check to defend against a two on one break. The play ended with Stamkos, arguably the leagues top player and a former 60 goal scorer dropping and blocking a shot off his ankle. That's the same Steven Stamkos who missed

65 games last season with a knee injury. Obviously Stamkos has learned the price that must be paid to win in the modern gritty NHL from hos boss GM Steve Yzerman, a three time Stanley Cup champion with the Detroit Red Wings. When was the last time Eichel or Sam Reinhart sacrificed their body to block a shot?

Stamkos scored 105 for the Markham Waxers midget team before graduating to the OHL juniors. I remember a scout saying that he's seen 50 kids playing minor hockey in the Toronto area who could score like young Stankos but they never made it to the OHL because they didn't back check and he did. Until the Sabres players including Jack Eichel learn to put defense first and play hard the playoffs will be nothing but a dream and the team will continue to contend for the league basement.
