

Bishop Malone To Distribute Ashes On February 14th

Bishop Richard J. Malone, bishop of Buffalo, will distribute ashes at the 12:05 pm Mass at St. Joseph Cathedral, 50 Franklin St., Buffalo, on Wednesday, February 14th, Ash Wednesday.

Church guidelines for Lent include, for all Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday, abstaining totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent including Good Friday. Catholics who are between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

Also, all Catholics who have made their First Communion are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This must be done during the Easter season, between February18th (first Sunday of Lent) and May 27th (Trinity Sunday), unless, for a good reason, it is fulfilled at another time.



Five Thoughts as the Buffalo Sabres Show Signs of Life

1. The Sabres dropped a 4-3 overtime decision to the Anaheim Ducks Tuesday night at Keybank Center. Old friend Ryan Miller was in goal for Anaheim and blocked 30 of 33 shots for the victory.

Each team had 33 shots as the Sabres dropped their fourth straight game. Buffalo continue to fail to get players to the net to screen the goalie and get to rebounds. Until they do so continuously they will continue to lose games.

2. Another old friend, former Sabre Derek Grant returned as an Anaheim Duck. Grant was known for never scoring a goal in 80 NHL career games including 40 games as a Sabre. He earned a roster spot here because of his proficiency at faceoffs which allowed Buffalo to occasionally rest faceoff wizard Ryan O'Reilly. All of a sudden Grant has become a goalscorer and has eight scores with the Ducks so far this season.

3. The announced attendance was 16,788, but thousands of those allegedly in attendance were dressed like blue seats. My crowd estimate is in the 12-13,000 range with 1/3 of the arena empty especially in the upper 300 level. of course it's a weeknight game and the opponent is not a big draw but these tickets were all sold and the holders just didn't show up or gave the tickets away. On the ticket resale website Stubhub.

com, those 300 level seats are typically available for six dollars and apparently they are overpriced.

4. Jack Eichel had a goal and an assists giving him 20 goals and 51 points ranking him 20th in the individual scoring race. Sam Reinhart has three goals and 10

points in his last nine games. Kyle Okposo has three goals and twelve points in his last eleven games. Rasmus Ristolainen has three goals and thirteen points in his last 15 games.

5. Connor McDavid fired four goals into the net Monday night and added an assist in a 6-2 rout for the Edmonton Oilers over the Tampa Bay Lightning. Those five points tied him for third in NHL scoring with 61 points just five behind league leader Nikita Kucherov of the Lightning who had a good view of McDavid's big night. At the end of the season count on McDavid winning his second consecutive Art Ross trophy as the leading scorer.
