Reddy ridership tripled in 2017.


Reddy bikeshare and Independent Health officials announced final results for the second season of the innovative bikeshare program in the City of Buffalo, and both organizations are once again extremely pleased with the community's incredible support and enthusiasm.

Jennifer White, marketing and communications executive for Reddy bikeshare, said "Riders utilizing the program more than tripled last year, growing from

1,700 in 2016 to more than 5,600 at the end of the 2017 season. Our data also shows an increased number of trips during peak commute times, indicating a growing commuter base. The use of Reddy bikes to commute to-and-Continued on page five.

Influenza Still Increasing in Erie County

This year's United States flu season has been driven by the H3N2 Influenza A strain, a flu strain that can lead to more severe illness with more hospitalizations and even deaths compared to other flu virus strains. Flu-related hospitalizations in Erie County remain ex-



tremely high. The number of positive influenza laboratory test results reported to Erie County continues to increase. The presence of influenza throughout Erie County is widespread and affecting all ages and is not an illness to be taken lightly.

It is NOT too late to receive a flu vaccine, and if you do get sick, it may reduce the severity of your symptoms. It is especially important for certain populations at high risk of developing serious complications, such as *Continued on page five.*

Five Thoughts as the Buffalo Sabres Show Signs of Life

1. Are the Sabres a better team without Jack Eichel? Of course this is a preposterous idea. Eichel's possibly season ending high ankle sprain injury suffered in Boston on Saturday on February 10th could drive the team into a deeper despair in an already ruined season.

Consider that following Eichel's injury against Boston on Saturday on February 10th, the team finished the game by defeating the league's hottest team 4-2. Back in Buffalo they dropped a 5-4 decision to the Colorado Avalanche the next day before defeating the first place team in the Eastern Conference, the Tampa Bay Lightning 5-3 on Tuesday February 13th. Tampa probably wasn't at their best having played the previous night in Toronto where they lost 4-3 to the Maple Leafs. But for a Sabres team with only 15 wins in 54 games prior to these back to back victories no one was complaining.

2. The Lighting spoiled the homecoming of former Canisius College star Cory Conacher by making him a healthy scratch. Conacher has been on a hockey odyssey since breaking in with Tampa in 2012 with a point and a half per game playing on a line with league MVP and scoring champion Martin St. Louis. He was traded to Ottawa for goalie Ben Bishop who be-

came a star in Tampa while Conacher underwhelmed in Ottawa with only six goals in 82 games. He ended up playing 19 game for Buffalo before beginning a minor league travel odyssey which also took him to the Swiss league. But Conacher is too good for the minors and he is back in the NHL where he has scored six goals in 24 games, a pace that would net him 20 goals over a full schedule.

3. Sam Rhinehart was Buffalo's best player against Tampa with two goals. He has been on a tear since returning to Jack Eichel's line and continues to produce following Eichel's injury. Rhinehart has gone 6-10-16 in his last 13 games including 2-1-3 in three games without Eichel. His production is welcome and makes one wonder if this is the same player who only registered 13 points in his first 44 games?

4. Ryan O'Reilly has stepped up his game lately with 14 points (6-8-14) in his last 11 games. He has three points in each of the last two home games. But where O'Reilly has really dazzled in the faceoff circle where he has won a league leading 831 faceoffs with a league leading 61.3 winning percentage. He won 29 of 39 draws for a 74.1 winning percentage against Colorado on Sunday. This was O'Reilly's career high for faceoff wins. Since the league began keeping faceoff stats 20 years ago only five players have won more than 29 faceoffs in a single regular season game.

5. The Sabres should make sure their players are awake for those opening faceoffs. Against Colorado the defense failed to see a Colorado forward slip behind them for a breakaway only 20 seconds into the game. To make matters even worse, a second Avalanche player joined the play to make it a two on none break in on poor goalie Robin Lehner. How is this possible in an NHL game? It's no wonder this team is in last place.



Snail Mail

When was the last time you received a letter in the mail? Probably been a while. And probably a good thing as it would take forever for vou to have it delivered by the good old United States Postal System. (USPS). One of the poorest run government agencies in existence today. Good thing for computers and email as it is the only way to communicate with any urgency. Sound like a problem exist with the Post Office? Let me give a few examples.

My birthday was February 7th. One thing that still means something is receiving birthday cards in the mail on your birthday. People still use the PO for sending cards. My daughter sent me her card post marked February 1st. I received it on February 8th. I received three more on the 9th and I know of at least four more that are still not here yet. (as of today February 13th, still at least four cards not received vet). There must be some reason for this as it was not always what we now call snail mail. Probably the fact that sending letters by mail is a thing of the past and has cut into revenue. Still stamps

are not cheap, and mail should be delivered in a timely manner. One positive thing I can say about today's Post Office is that they do deliver priority flat rate packages on time. It is amazing how fast they can turn these items around. So why do they find delivering basic mail so difficult?

Another interesting fact about the PO, is slow down Tuesdays, at our place of business we receive no mail on Tuesdays. Have not for some years now to the point of expecting it. Monday is good and so is the rest of the week. Just Tues-Unless Monday days. is a holiday. As I understand it, the Union did not like when the PO implemented working on Saturdays. In retaliation Postal workers slow down on Tuesdays. They deny it but still we do not get mail on Tuesdays.

One last thing as I go on about our friendly mail people. It is a tough job in Buffalo with the snow and ice and frigid weather. Here in Florida, (where I spend my winters) there is none of that to contend with. So, most of the Postal workers up North have to be dedicated and hard working. But not all

are so dedicated, and because of that, some postal options are not what the PO claim. Take EDDM, for example, Every Door Direct Mail. Supposedly if you sigh up to EDDM in a certain zip code, every mail box will get your mail piece. Sounds great and in most cases, it does

We designed a mail piece that had multiple advertisements on it to make it more affordable businesssmaller es. Paid and sent them out EDDM. Worked well in some zips but not so good in others. It is easy to check the delivery as if every door is supposedly a recipient all you do is contact anyone in the zip chosen and see if they received it. Unfortunately, there are some Postal workers who feel every door is asking too much. The Post Office insist that they are all being delivered. Hey, the proof is in the pudding. We even had it down to where we knew the routes that were done poorly. Even with some not doing their job, enough are delivered to

from work further indicates the system is being used as an extension of public transit and to replace trips in a personal vehicle."

Another highlight of the 2017 season included member Robby Takac of the Goo Goo Dolls using a Reddy bike to navigate the grounds for the annual Music is Art Festival held at Buffalo Riverworks in September. "I spent 15 hours darting from place to place on a Reddy Bike at

"Over the next few months, we will look to add some expansion locations for 2018," said White. "We believe 2018 will be another great year for biking in the Buffalo Niagara region with our continued growth in number of stations as well as

partnerships within the community. We will continue to find fun engagement opportunities to allow for folks to get on a Reddy bike for the first time. From page one. pneumonia, be vaccinated. Individuals with medical conditions such as asthma, diabetes, morbid obesity, and chronic lung disease are at a higher risk of complications. "The flu is highly contagious and can cause serious respiratory illness. Now is the time to get a flu vaccine if you

have not already been immu-

nized this season," said Dr.

Gale Burstein, Erie Coun-

ty Commissioner of Health. "Erie County's flu seasons lasts well into the spring, so we still have a few months of potentially prevalent disease on our community."

Influenza vaccine is still in good supply in Erie County. Local pharmacies report good flu vaccine availability, including flu vaccines for children, if your health care provider or urgent care facility has limited supply.




