

Rhinehart, Sabres Exceed **Expectations Without Eichel**

When Jack Eichel went down with a high ankle sprain against the Boston Bruins on February 10th a sense of impending doom enveloped the team. It seemed as if the horrible season would get even worse for the NHL's second worst team. Surprisingly, the teams record without Eichel has improved to .500 at 5-5-1. Leading the way has been Sam Reinhart who has turned his season around and seized the title of the teams best player in Eichel's absence.

The season began inauspiciously for Rhinehart going without a point in the first six games including a minus five rating in the second game during a 6-3 loss to the New York Islanders on October 7th. His season stats totaled only 10 points on five goals and five assists through the first 25 games. And then things got even worse.

Over a 25 game stretch from November 24th through January 11th, Rhinehart tallied only three points. This was a period of time when coach Phil Housley had been using him primarily at center which was the position he had been drafted for. Rhinehart's best success with Buffalo has been at right wing. Skating speed is not his strength. He is a below average NHL skater but this deficiency is not as profound on the wing where

he does not need to carry the puck up ice as much as the center or come back as deep into the defensive zone. So coach Housley returned Rhinehart to the wing on Jack Eichel's line.

Rhinehart responded with some very impressive player as shown by scoring 23 points in his last 22 games. Rhinehart's offensive instincts are on display in the attacking zone when he positions himself in front of the opponents goalie and and also when he distributes the puck with his passing skills.

When Eichel was injured, the Sabres responded by finishing the game with a surprising 4-2 win against Boston, then the leagues hottest team. They followed up a disappointing 5-4 loss to Colorado where the Sabres surrendered a two on none break just 20 seconds into the game with an impressive 5-3 win against the league leading Tampa Bay Lightning.

Then on Saturday February 17th the Los Angeles Kings treated the Kids day crowd at Keybank Center with 19 shots in the first 19 minutes enroute to an easy 4-2 win. During the game GM Jason Botterill slammed the door in the press box in disgust. Even Coach Housley lost his cool, and reacted by putting the team through a grueling practice the next day. The Sabres responded with four wins in their next six games including impressive victories against Boston and Tampa Bay again and Toronto, all top teams. And it all starts with defense. As Evan Rodriguez stated during the streak, all players are responsible on the defensive side of the puck with no one cheating offensively.

The question is if the team can subtract their top two players, Jack Eichel and Evander Kane, why are they competing for the top draft choice rather than a playoff spot? More on this later.

Daylight saving begins at 2 am for many good reasons, such as most people are at home in bed. Few people will likely wake up exactly at 2:00 am local time to move the clock hand, or dial, forward an hour. But that's when daylight saving time officially begins on the second Sunday in March. It ends on the first Sunday in November, when clocks are turned back at 2:00 am lo-

cal time to read 1:00 am. Why two o'clock? The thinking goes it's late enough that most people would be at home. In addition, it prevented the date from switching to yesterday; it would be confusing if, say, we changed the clocks at midnight back to 11 pm. The time is also early enough that the clock-hand change occurs before early shift workers and early churchgoers might be impacted.


