# Sabres Miserable Season Will Bring Reward

With 57 points in 69 games, the Arizona Coyotes finally moved past Buffalo and the Sabres have fallen into the league basement with 56 points. This will be remembered as the season where 6-7,000 fans stay home nearly every game and seem unable to even give their tickets away. It's been the greatest outward migration of Sabres fans since the 2004-05 season when crowds of 5,000-6.000 were common as the team finished fifth from the bottom in the standings.

The "reward" for their poor season was the fifth overall choice in the annual entry draft which the Sabres used to select Thomas Vanek. Over his career with Buffalo, Vanek played 598 goals scoring 254 goals and 497 points. In 953 NHL games, Vanek has 325 goals and 741 points. Needless to say, the Vanek selection was very productive for the Sabres.

Imagine if Buffalo had finished in last place and been awarded the first overall pick in that draft, Alex Ovechkin. With 600 career goals and 1109 points in 990 games Ovechkin is one of the greatest goal scorers in NHL history. He currently is 20th in career goal scoring. By the end of his career, he will likely be challenging Gordie Howe's 801 goals for second overall behind Wayne Gretzky's 894

And this was accomplished primarily in the leagues defensive era.

While the Sabres tank seasons brought a second overall pick in Jack Eichel into the organization, there is a huge talent difference between him and Connor Mac-David the number one pick. The number one prospect eligible for the 2018 NHL Entry Draft is Swedish Rasmus Dahlin. Like MacDavid and Ovechkin, Dahlin is head and shoulders above the other prospects eligible for the draft. He is projected as the next great NHL defenseman.

The team finishing in last place this season will have an 18% chance of winning the draft lottery to receive the number one pick and the right to acquire Dahlin.

While there are plenty of outstanding prospects projected for picks two through five, the Sabres need elite players to move forward and become a contending team. The two time defending Stanley Cup champion Pittsburgh Penguins have four elite players, Sydney Crosby, Evgeni Malkin (2nd leading NHL scorer), Phil Kessel (7th leading scorer) and Kris Letang. Buffalo has one, Jack Eichel. And Eichel hasn't even scored 60 points yet in a single season so his elite status is long on potential, short on NHL production. Pittsburgh got lucky following the lockout season and was awarded the number one pick netting them Crosby. This organization needs an influx of talent and that can begin with a bit of luck in this years draft lottery.







### Buffalo Rocket, how did it start?

Last week on the front page of the Buffalo Rocket we had photos of some of the business people that made up North Buffalo back when I created the paper in 1969. Next year, if both the paper and I survive we will celebrate our 50th anniversary. All the people in those photos were advertisers in the Rocket who I personally knew and called on. We became friends and had wonderful relationships. What I would like to do is go over the last 49 years and share some of the things I remember about being a part of the growth and resurgence of North Buffalo and the West Side. It will take more than one issue so bear with me and make sure to get following issues if you want to hear the whole story.

If you have not read a past column about my start in business in the basement of my West Side home, the story is on the Gallagher Printing website. It does explain living the American dream. One press in my basement with seven drawers of foundry type. That is how it started but that is another story.

My beginning in North Buffalo, back then it was called North Park, began with buying a building at 277 Tacoma. Born and raised and having my eight children on the West Side of Buffalo, going into a new neighborhood which I knew nothing about was a challenge. It was a more affluent area and back then North Park was still predominately Jewish. It became apparent that the Italian descendants from the West Side were emigrating to the North and the Jewish residents found a home in Amherst. Turned out that within a few years a lot of my West Side friends had settled in what was to become the home of the Italian Festival and Little Italy.

I quit my full-time job to open my print shop on Tacoma. Not a smart move as Tacoma is not exactly the most traveled street and not the place to open a business that warrants walk in traffic. Opened in February and by May knew unless I did something me and my family would have to eat cereal for dinner. So, I came up with the idea of distributing a flyer in the immediate neighborhood using my one great resource, my eight children. I would print them, and my kids would distribute them door to door. Problem was I did not have enough money to even print the flyer.

This young fellow, 15-year-old, Rich Briandi used to hang around the print shop on Tacoma looking for work. I had no money to pay him, but he just enjoyed being there, so he would just help. When the

idea of the flyer hit me, I asked him if he would like to go up on Hertel and see if anyone would like to place their business card as an ad on our flyer. He came back with enough money to print the flyer and that was the first North Buffalo Rocket. Why the Rocket name? That was back when space travel was the big topic. What better name for a space age communication vehicle than "Rocket". I was the first "Rocket Man" and that did not bother me.

The previous free newspaper for the area was the North Park Advertiser. I did not want to limit the distribution to North Park, so I called it the North Buffalo Rocket. I would like to take claim to the fact that I was the one who originally came up with the North Buffalo name. I recall telling someone that there is a South Buffalo why not a North Buffalo? Since Delaware Park was such a huge area identity, the surrounding area was Parkside, Central Park and North Park. The first two remain but the North Park name is almost extinct.

Next week, Meeting the 1970's merchants, business men, and politicians of North Buffalo as a dumb kid who bit off more than he could chew.


