The Class of '64 had a lot of its members serve our Country in some capacity during the Viet-



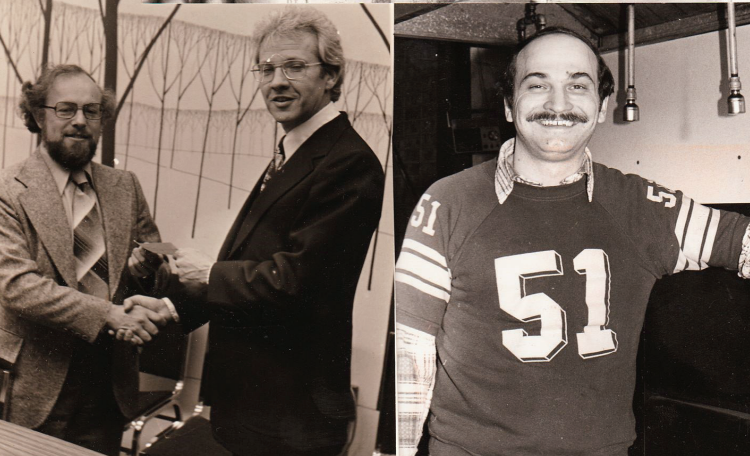



Opening Day HNPYBL

The Hertel North Park Youth Baseball League opened their 62nd season in North Buffalo in grand style with marvelous temperatures to match this past Saturday, May 5th, with a lengthy parade up Hertel Avenue to Shoshone Park.

By 11:30 am hundreds of children gathered behind St. Margaret's Church near Saranac Avenue with their coaches, wearing new uniform shirts and matching caps, ready to play ball in front of friends and family. People lined the street on both sides of the busy thoroughfare to watch along with several business owners while a police and fire escort helped keep everyone safe.

"It's a glorious day finally and now its time for spring,"

said one resident watching the festivities, "this is great."

Thanks to St. Margaret's Church, the Hertel North Park Youth Baseball and Softball League is still able to use that corner at Saranac to begin their season, just as they have in years past. Last seasons opening day was cancelled due to weather, making this years event that much sweeter.

Leading the parade was longtime League president Don Morris who has guided the baseball and softball program since the early 1990's and kept the sport alive in the City of Buffalo. Special guests invited echoed that sentiment as well including Buffalo Common Council members Joel Feroleto of the Delaware

District and Rasheed N.C. Wyatt of the University District. Also invited guests were Erie County Legislator Peter Savage of the 3rd District and City Comptroller Mark Schroeder. Also making an appearance was Buffalo Mayor Byron Brown, who used to parade route to pass out bubble gum treats to various teams.

At the Park, around diamond #1, Morris used a microphone and asked the roughly 900 kids registered to play this season, the most they've had in some time, to turn around and thank their parents for taking them to the Park. He politely asked every child to thank their coaches in advance for helping them this season. The special guests proclaimed of the Leagues status in the City in youth sports and then threw a baseball or softball from the mound to signify a first pitch. Winning raffle ticket winners were announced and then the City Honors High School Chorus sang our National Anthem just before those two words were yelled: "Play Ball!"

Close to 20 games were played by boys and girls by 1:30 pm and lasted until early evening. The Dodgers defeated the Giants 6-4 on a walk off homerun by Xavier Mann in the bottom of the sixth inning, that hit a small tree in the park, beyond the left field fence. It was a homerun kind of a day for North Buffalo.

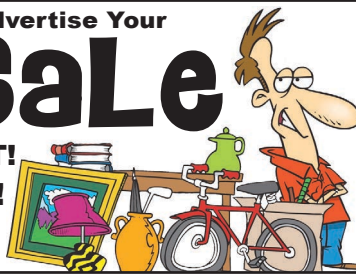
