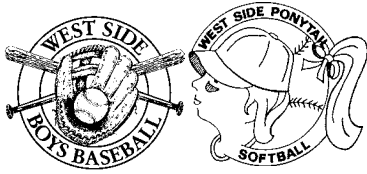
cheer. This event is for the kids and we ask that they have adults present with them. Please follow Covid social distancing and mask restrictions while walking Hertel.

## North Buffalo Hockey On Ice!

For over 30 years, the North Buffalo Ice Rink on Tacoma Avenue has been the site of countless hockey games on the amateur level, but there's nothing amateur in the way it's run. Since 2014, the North Buffalo Bisons Hockey Organization skated in and offered boys and girls a chance to lace up their skates and learn to play Canada's Sport in a newer facility. Playing most games out of the Dann Memorial Rink on the Nichols Campus, Tacoma Avenue offered more space to meet the needs of a growing League that has been a part of Western New York's hockey history since 1959 with the Shamrocks Athletic Club.

After some building renovations, the Rink welcomed visiting teams from as many as 30 amateur leagues that make up a part of the Western New York Amateur Hockey Association that stretches from here, Niagara Falls, Jamestown, Olean, Rochester and Syracuse. Besides offering play in five levels of hockey, Mite, Squirt, Pee Wee, Bantam and Midget, the Bisons were able to host many tournaments over the years at the Tacoma Rink.

Until a ban was lifted by the CDC and the WHO in late January, a season didn't get underway until February 1st. That's when North Buffalo Rink Manager Nick Price and his team worked around the clock to sanitize and clean the

rink before the season could begin. With another entrance to the building leading out to an expanded parking lot built in 2016, the Bisons have been able to safely weather the storm of this Coronavirus and defeat an opponent no one ever thought boys and girls would have to fight a little over a year ago.

The Bisons, under Hockey Director Jamie Printz, the long-time coach at Nichols School has overseen a program vital to area youth today. With his team of coaches in both boys and girls travel, the organization boasts an enrollment of over 400 athletes. It starts young in the Initiation Program under Nick Beaver, Adam Bellows and Joe Leber and moves right on up to the Midget level with Rick Bertucca and Steve Casey. Printz works with a 10 and under girls team and watches over girls still playing at 19 and possibly in College.

As big as the boys program is in WNY, the North Buffalo Bisons have seen their greatest success in

the play of their girls teams. There's presently just five girls teams in North Buffalo, 10u, 12u, 14u, 16u and 19. But the Bisons have been the witness to watch a now 27 year old Women's hockey player grow up and play in North Buffalo on Tacoma and at Nichols School. Her name is Emily Pfalzer and not only was she the first team captain of the Buffalo Beauts from 2015-2017. She was a part of the winning Women's Hockey team that won a gold medal in the 2018 Winter Olympics in Pyeongchang, South Korea, defeating Canada 3-2 in a shoot-out.

"These girls start here in North Buffalo and they play well enough to get invitations to play in Division I and III Schools," said Mike Beecher, the Bisons vice-president recently. "Schools like Providence, Vermont, Boston College, Ivy Schools like Cornell and Yale, Brooke Becker is another who played at Providence."

The Bisons will be ready to lace up their skates again in September.

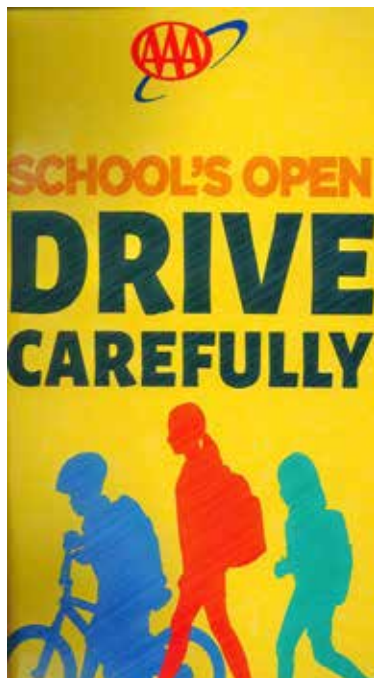

## Ask Rusty- Will Inheritance Money Affect My Social Security?

*Dear Rusty: I will turn 66 this year and am considering claiming my Social Security. I have already applied for Medicare. My parents passed on several years ago, and the estate will probably settle this year. I would like to know if my inheritance money will have any effect on my social security benefits. If so, how? Signed: Wondering Heir*

**Dear Wondering:** No, your inheritance money from your parents' estate will not affect your gross Social Security benefit in any way. Your monthly SS benefit is based solely on your lifetime earnings record from working, and income from other sources is not counted when computing your Social Security benefit amount. But if you claim your benefits and have your Medicare Part B premium deducted from your Social Security payment, it's possible your inheritance could affect your Medicare Part B premium amount, thus lowering your net Social Security payment.

Most Medicare beneficiaries pay a standard premium of \$148.50 per month (2021 amount) for Part B, which is coverage for doctors and other outpatient services. But there is also a special provision known as "IRMAA" (Income Related Medicare Adjustment Amount) which adds a supplemental amount to the standard Part B premium if your "provisional income" from all sources exceeds certain levels. Your "provisional income" would include income from all sources, including any money you receive from an inheritance, any tax-advantage investment withdrawals, tax free interest, and half of the Social Security benefits you received during the tax year. The name for this is your "Modified Adjusted Gross Income" (MAGI), and the clip levels which cause IRMAA to affect your Medicare premium are different depending on your IRS filing status.

If you file your income tax as "married/jointly"

and your MAGI is over \$176,000, then IRMAA will apply and you'll pay a higher Medicare premium thus reducing your net Social Security payment (if you file as a single, the clip level is \$88,000). IRMAA can cause your Part B premium to go to anywhere from \$208 to \$505 per month, depending upon how high your MAGI is. Note that your Medicare premium for the current year is determined by your MAGI from 2 years prior, so if that inheritance money is reported on your 2021 income tax return, it would be your 2023 Medicare premium amount that would be affected. And the

higher Medicare premium would self-adjust back to a lower level if MAGI for subsequent years are below the IRMAA level.

The other way your inheritance might affect you is through income taxes on your Social Security benefits. If your MAGI exceeds \$32,000 filing as married/jointly (\$25,000 if single), then 50% of your Social Security benefits will become part of your taxable income. Or if your MAGI is more than \$44,000 filing as married/jointly (\$34,000 if single), then up to 85% of your Social Security benefits for the tax year will become part of your taxable income at your standard IRS tax rate.

The bottom line is this: Your gross monthly Social Security benefit amount will not be affected by your inheritance, but if your inheritance increases your Medicare Part B premium your net SS benefit will be temporarily lower. And the inheritance may also influence how much of your Social Security benefits are subjected to income tax.

### When I Was A Kid Part Three

With all the news about schools closing and re-opening I thought I would reminisce about how it was when I was a kid. Things were a lot different then and in some cases it is much better now than it was then. Not so much that computers have taken over as a learning tool, but just the fact that school was a place to socialize. Be with people your own age on a daily basis. The same kids, the same teachers, committed to go to the same building every day. To be disciplined as a group with rules to follow. Having to be there at a certain time, following a daily routine, having to listen when you are supposed to and speak only when asked to.

You had to be in your seat when the bell rang to start the day. They had attendance records and would award those who were never tardy or missed a day all year. From the moment that bell rang, the teacher was the

boss. You did exactly as she said, (I say she as there were almost no male teachers in Grammar school, did not pay enough.) If you didn't you were subject to some sort of punishment. Back then the teacher was allowed to give you a slap when necessary. I know that from personal experience as I was slapped plenty of times. Once even by the principal, Ms Mason, and by various teachers. My fifth grade teacher slapped me so many times one day I had to go home to change my bloody clothes.

I attended school 18 on the West side. It was a brand new recently opened state of the art deco building. It had a huge gym, large playground, three floors, spacious halls, a cafeteria and an up to date woodworking shop and chemistry lab. All you could ask for in a learning facility. I had gone up to third grade at old school 38 before that and it had none of those amenities. It

was old and was torn down not too long after I left. My new school was exciting just to walk in. Everything was clean and new and what was important to me, it had girls. Unfortunately our family did not have enough money for private or Catholic school so we attended public institutions. This school had an increasing attendance and was built to handle the much larger capacity.

Not all the teachers used to beat on me. In fact most were extremely nice. At that time teachers were underpaid and overworked. One punishment inflicted was having to stay after school. Been there and done that. Point is the teacher and was also there till five o'clock with me. Not sure how it works now but they used to put in a full day and often took papers to be corrected home with them. Like I said it was a poor paying job and most men opted out of teaching the lower grades. Not so in High School. There at least half of the teachers were male as it paid a little more.

I attended Grover Cleveland High School also on the West Side. The school was a mile from my home and there were no school buses except for handicapped students. So it was to walk the mile each way, every day. No

wonder I was so thin then. In fact as I recall, everyone was thin, probably from walking to school every day. This school had lots of male teachers. There was no slapping as I recall. There was an occasional fight between a student and a teacher. Usually perpetrated by a student hitting a teacher. Then the teacher does whatever necessary to calm the situation. It was a rough school and lots and lots of fist fights on a daily basis. I do not think it is that way now.

Going back to public schools compared to Catholic schools. My kids went to both. The older ones went to Nativity on the West Side. When we could no longer afford the tuition, they had to transfer to school 77. At Nativity they had mostly Nuns running the show. We have all heard the horror

stories of how Nuns treat their students. Never had one of my kids come home to change their bloody clothes. Of course they also never did at 77.

Although we have no regrets for sending our eldest to a stricter Nun run school, there were shortcomings. No extracurricular activities at Nativity. No sports, no gym, no clubs or music which public schools excel in. We then sent all our three girls to all girls Catholic High Schools. Mt. St Joseph's, Bishop McMahon and Holy Angels. Not sure if they still exist.

Point is here that schools are important for the well being of the child. Did not realize how important, not only for learning but for the social environment until this pandemic hit. Hopefully it is over to a degree and kids can go back to school. Public or private, just school.

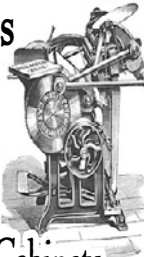
