Ask Rusty - Social Security's WEP is Unfair – I Want My Money Back!

Dear Rusty: How can a foreign company pay into the U.S. Social Security system? I worked in Barbados before I immigrated to the USA and earned a pension there. Now my U.S. Social Security benefits are reduced because I receive a pension from Barbados. One has nothing to do with the other, and I want my money back! **Signed: Angry Immigran**

Dear Angry: Foreign companies don't pay into the

U.S. Social Security system, and neither do residents of other countries working in their home country. But a resident of a foreign country who earns a pension in their home country and who later moves to the U.S. and earns an additional U.S. Social Security pension will have their U.S. Social Security benefit reduced by a provision of U.S. law called the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). WEP was enacted by Congress

in 1983 to eliminate what was viewed as “double-dipping” – where someone with an extra pension (such as your Barbados pension earned without contributing to U.S. Social Security) had their U.S. Social Security (S.S.) benefit computed in the same way as a U.S. resident who had no such extra “non-covered” pension. The 1983 WEP rule created a special formula for those entitled to both a U.S. Social Security benefit (earned by contributing to the U.S. program) and an-

other pension earned without contributing to Social Security. Though you are adamant that one has nothing to do with the other, U.S. law says otherwise. WEP reduces the U.S. Social Security benefit of anyone with a “non-covered” (e.g., foreign) pension so that their U.S. Social Security benefit is more consistent with benefits provided to others without an extra non-covered pension. U.S. Social Security is designed to provide a higher percentage of replacement

income to lower-income workers, and those with an extra non-covered pension enjoy an unfair advantage because their income artificially appears lower than it truly is. WEP was implemented by Congress to correct that unfair advantage. However, like you, almost everyone affected by WEP (which, by the way, includes many public service employees in 27 U.S. states) believes it to be unfair and often complains about it to their Congressional Representatives.

A run at another Super Bowl and a win this time. Not everyone is on this Buffalo Bills bandwagon as the connection was never made. It is a violent sport where men hit each other viciously on every play. Sometimes extremely hard and believe me it hurts. Been there and done that. Played football in High School at Grover Cleveland as a young youth. This was before football had the protection that is now provided, was in place.

The helmets we wore in my first year there did not have any face mask. Just like a leather hat you put it on your head and it covered your ears. Little padding and then of course your face was totally ex-

posed. Terrific way to lose your teeth. I recall Donny Miola blocking a punt with his face. Imagine what he looked like the next day at school. Two black eyes and a broken nose. Still played the next game. Must be something about showing how tough you are. You watch the pros and the way they hit and think nothing about it. Want to tell you something, it hurts. It hurts all over, but you cannot show it. Players play hurt and do their best to stay in the game. I even recall in little league football at Shoshone Park years ago, a kid playing with a broken leg. Parents telling him to suck it up and get back in there. He was the quarterback and the team needed him. He of course could not continue despite their pleading. Extreme but I saw it happen. Football is a violent sport, but people really enjoy watching it. They love the

hitting, the harder the better. No idea what it feels like, but it hurts. They are athletes and can take it. There were times I saw stars after making a tackle on the playing field. You know it is going to hurt but it must be done. Back in those days you really did not do it for the hopes of moving on and making it a career. You just did it for fun or whatever glory you brought to your school. In my first year at Grover, the school had never won a game since it started a football program, which was years ago. The first win was like celebrating winning the Super Bowl. Later years we even went to the Turkey Bowl for the first time on Thanksgiving Day. We played for the city championship at All High Stadium. We lost but it was

such fun.

The High School programs years ago were not really a stepping stone to win scholarships like they are now. We barely had twenty-two players on our squad, and we used to play both ways. I was a tight end on offense and a defensive end on defense. Makes for a long game with no rest. It was tough to recruit players to play as it meant getting hurt. Still, we did it. Every member of the teams I played on I remember. Some more than others but the comradery was special.

In my senior year there was a fellow who had never played before. Walked on and was terrific. One of those gifted guys who you knew were going to be a star. Considerable size, well built and fast. Caught the ball with such

ease and made it look like it was nothing. The coach Missana was excited to get him, and he did well in the few games he played. He could have become a super star. Unfortunately, he was found dead in a field with another person killed mob style. Seems he was with the wrong guy at the wrong time and paid for it with his life. Mob violence was common back then. Too bad as he was just a teenager with a bright future.

Next time you sit in your comfortable chair or couch and watch a football game, think about the pain these people are going through to entertain you. The hurt they are enduring for a measly million dollars or more to make you happy. Hmmm, that does not sound that bad. Go Bills!
