No Lock-Out In North Buffalo!

Look at your new 2022 Calendar and find Saturday, May 7th and circle it as the Opening Day for the Hertel North Park Youth Baseball League Season in Shoshone Park this Summer.

Meetings are already taking place in North Buffalo locations to plan and play another fantastic season of Little League Baseball and Softball for all the boys and girls who wish to register now, so as not to get left out of the fun and excitement that comes with winning a Championship trophy.

While Major League Baseball has decided to shut down this season since December 2nd of last year, there is no such thing as a lock-out for a North Buffalo League that has been offering neighbourhood Sports to literally thousands of area children, boys and girls from ages three and four to fifteen and sixteen. It's been a homerun for everyone since 1957, when just four boys teams were formed to play weekly in Shoshone Park.

Now, with over 65 teams playing on eight diamonds in the Park on Hertel Avenue near Main Street, boys and girls are beginning to count down the days towards warmer weather that Spring brings. For as little as \$110.00, your son or daughter can sign up now to ensure a season spent close to home, in a neighbourhood Park with possibly all their friends, wearing new baseball caps and jerseys of MLB teams like the Yankees or Blue Jays or any other team, just like the Professionals.

But I'm just getting to first base here because there's other opportunities to play the game on more than one team. Hertel North Park has a very strong travel program for both boys and girls. The boys teams are nicknamed Blaze and the girls teams are called the Wildcats. They compete against other leagues across Western New York like Lou Gehrig, Mathewson/Mc-Carthy and several others. There's a team for both boys and girls as young as eight years old all the way up to fifteen and sixteen and their seasons play during the house Shoshone teams. While many children are still learning the game in the house league, others are using their skills to compete in other Parks against their travel teams.

One thing is for certain every year for North Buffalo. The Hertel North Park Youth Baseball League and Shoshone Park is the best place to play the game inside the City of Buffalo and in WNY. That's according to Buffalo Mayor Byron W. Brown, who has made several visits to Shoshone Park on Opening Day and others to witness all the fun and excitement in a Shoshone season. He has been a friend

to the League since his first term in office and is always welcome.

You can register your son or daughter to play by going to www.hnpybl.com and clicking on the tab marked "2022 Season" on your computer. If this is their first year at ages 3, 4 or 5, the cost is only \$60 for a learning experience beginning in late June and July. Hitting and catching and throwing is where it all begins for everyone.

Last season, over 1000 kids signed up to play, the most ever for North Buffalo. But sadly, some families had to be put on a waiting list for some teams if they tried to register close to Opening

Day.

Locally, North Buffalo businesses have been supporting the League in various ways. Team uniforms are provided by Laux Sporting Goods in most cases but a child's t-shirt and cap comes with the help of Bob and John's La Hacienda, Korona Jewellers and Johnny's Meats, among others. If you know of a local business wishing to sponsor a team this season, you may contact the league at info.hnpybl. com.

There's approximately 115 days left until Opening Day 2022. Boys and girls are already starting to count them down. Let's play ball.



Ask Rusty - Why Is a Medicare Premium Deducted from my Social Security?

Dear Rusty: If I work and take Social Security before my full retirement age, how can I find out how I will be paid back the money withheld after I pass the earnings limit? Signed: Returning to Work

Dear Returning: What you're referring to is that Social Security limits how much you can earn while collecting early benefits (before your full retirement age, or "FRA"). The earnings limit for 2022 is \$19,560, and if your earnings exceed that while collecting early SS benefits, you'll

be required to pay back some of your benefits.

Except during the year in which you attain your FRA, you'll have to give SS back benefits equal to \$1 for every \$2 you are over the limit, which can be done either by having your benefits withheld for a time or repaying what is owed in a lump sum. In the year you reach your FRA, the limit goes up by about 2.5 times, and the amount you need to pay back is less, and after you reach your full retirement age, there is no longer a limit to how much you can earn. But if you have benefits withheld because you exceeded the limit while collecting early benefits, you will get some of that withheld money back after you have reached your full retirement age.

When you reach your FRA, Social Security will automatically adjust (increase) your benefit to reflect the number of months your benefits were withheld. So, for example, if you originally claimed Social Security at age 63 but were still working and, over time, you had benefits withheld for 12 months because you exceeded the earnings limit, they'll recompute your benefit at your FRA as though you applied 12 months later than you actually did. That will happen automatically and will slightly increase your monthly benefit amount starting at your full retirement age. So, you don't get all withheld money back in a lump sum - rather, they increase your benefit a bit at your FRA so that eventually, over time, you may recover what was withheld because you exceeded the limit.
