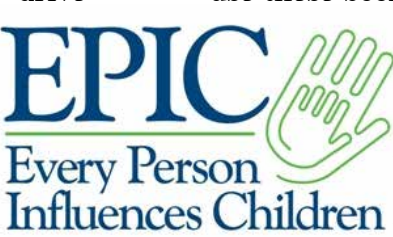
EPIC Receives Massive Book Donation From Channel 7

The Red Jacket Award was established in 1957 in recognition of “quiet, continued, unbroken devotion to our civic progress and needs by one who, through such devotion, has thereby enlarged our awareness of our heritage in order that it may be built upon for the enrichment of our future.”

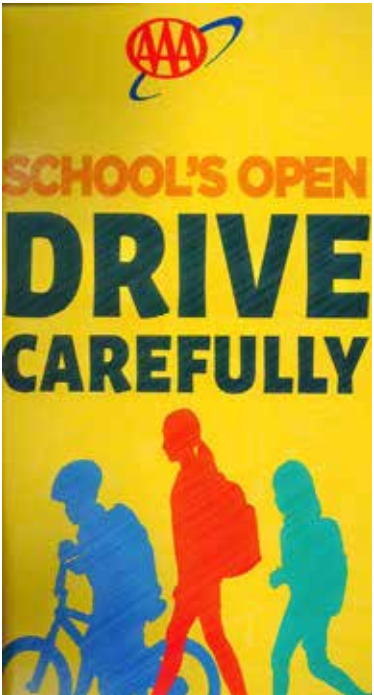
The award is named after the renowned orator and Seneca leader, Sagoyewatha, or Red Jacket. In 1792, President George Washington presented Red Jacket with the medal after which the award is modeled. The Red Jacket Medal was repatriated from the museum to the Seneca Nation of Indi-

ans in a ceremony in May 2021. Nearly seven inches tall, the medal bears symbolic imagery of peaceful coexistence between United States and Native Americans. The tradition of The Red Jacket Award is inspired by the imperative to continue to acknowledge those who, with steady service, strive to support the connections in our region with our heritage.

The Daniel B. Augspurger Award was established in 1974 in honor of Augspurger, a former History Museum president, and a Red Jacket honoree. The award is presented to an individual for outstanding service to the cause of local history.

The Daniel B. Niederlander Award was established in 1975, in honor

of Niederlander, a former History Museum president, businessman, and dedicated civic leader. The award is given to a local education, cultural or heritage organization for outstanding programming.

Evelyn Street – Officers observed defendant operating vehicle on Military when patrol vehicle LPR hit a stolen vehicle. Officer attempted to pull over vehicle at Sunnyside and Hertel when defendant did flee eastbound on Hertel. Eventually turning onto Military at a high rate of speed. Officers maintained visual of the vehicle when defendant did turn onto Evelyn from Ontario crashing into a show bank and fleeing on foot. Defendant was apprehended operating a

Patrol officer did ask driver to step out of vehicle and did find an "Altoid" case in the front left pant pocket of defendant containing a grayish powder substance that came back valid for Fentanyl. Peoria Street – Officers did observe vehicle traveling eastbound on Grace Street towards Peoria Street which was reported stolen. Upon investigation detectives did recover a Taurus Mill TR11 PT111 Pro, 9mm, 2 (9mm) Lugar rounds were located next to the said firearm in one magazine loaded with 10 (9mm) rounds was loaded in the drawer above it. The firearm and 2 rounds were in the defendant's middle dresser drawer and the magazine with 16 (9mm) rounds were located on the top dresser drawer. Detective did recover a Spike's Tactical, Model St15 multi caliber Assault Rifle which did have in close proximity. Inside of a Sentry Safe were 2 magazines, 1 containing (45) 556 cartridges and another magazine containing (1) 223 cartridge. Said weapon qualified as an assault rifle due to having flash suppressor pistol grip and collapsible

buttstock. Defendant was previously convicted of a crime on 2/15/2007.

Oxford Place – Victim stated that her and defendant did get into a verbal argument that did turn physical when defendant did strike victim in right eye by means of closed fist which did cause swelling and pain to eye. Ask Rusty – Swiss Immigrant Asks About Spouse Benefits

Dear Rusty: I am originally from Switzerland. I moved to the States, got married in 2012, and became a US Citizen in 2016. I never worked in the United States but have 44 years of Social Security contribution in Switzerland and have received a pension from there since I turned 62 (I'm now 64). Is it correct that I cannot apply for Social Security here in the States on my husband's account unless he is collecting his Social Security benefit? He will turn 62 this year but is still working and does not want to collect before 70. **Signed: Immigrant from Switzerland**

Dear Immigrant: Yes, it is correct that you cannot collect U.S. Social Security spousal benefits from your husband until he starts collecting his own Social Security benefit. As soon as your husband's benefits start, you can apply for your benefit as his spouse, even though you aren't eligible

for U.S. Social Security on your own. As a U.S. Citizen and current legal resident of the United States, you are eligible for U.S. spousal benefits from your husband even though you spent most of your life as a resident of Switzerland.

Since you mentioned your contributions to the Swiss social security program, I'd like to point out that there is a Social Security

"totalization" agreement between the U.S. and Switzerland which permits using some of your Swiss credits to qualify for U.S. Social Security retirement benefits, but since you have never worked in the U.S. that bilateral agreement won't work for you. To use some of your Swiss credits to get U.S. Social Security on your own, you would need to have at least six (6)

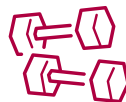
credits from working in the U.S. in a job which contributed to the U.S. Social Security program. Unless you have at least 6 U.S. Social Security credits, you cannot use the bilateral agreement with Switzerland to get your own SS retirement benefit, so you will need to wait until your husband claims his Social Security to start collecting spouse benefits from him.
