

Ice At Canalside To Open For 2025-2026 Season On Nov. 21



The annual Ice at Canalside opens again Friday, November 21.

As Western New Yorkers savor this fall's above-average temperatures, Buffalo Waterfront gears up for the cold as staff prepare the Ice at Canalside, presented by Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield, for a Nov. 21 opening. Reservations are now open for season passes, oneday skating passes, group outings, igloo rentals and curling.

"It's hard to believe we just wrapped up our Seneca Casinos Outer Harbor Live concert series on Friday night with an electric performance by T-Pain, and now we're diving right into the next season," said Lau-ren Ford, general manager, Buffalo Waterfront. "We encourage everyone to check out advance ticket options and make reservations early to enjoy everything the rink has to offer this winter."

For those making holiday plans with family or just looking for a fun night out, a group of eight can rent an igloo for 90 minutes, with passes for ice skating, skate rentals and hot chocolate, for just \$25 per person (with a \$200 package). New this year, pre-sale skating passes are also available in advance online.

The rink will open Friday, Nov. 21 for its 2025-2026 season debut, with a grand opening planned for Friday evening and a celebration of the Hallmark Channel movie Holiday Touchdown: A Bills Love Story on Saturday. For the first time ever, the rink will open on Thanksgiving, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Bumper cars, curling and ice bikes return to the Ice at Canalside, as well as weekly programming, including:

· Festive Fridays, featuring weekly themes ranging from Harry Potter Night to Pokémon to Silent Discos

· Special Event Saturdays, featuring events like a Buffalo Bandits celebration, Jingle Bell Rock the Ice and Ice Festival

· Learn to Skate lessons on Saturday mornings with Skate Great

Kids Club Sundays, which will debut after the New Year

"Each fall, as the temperatures drop, Western New Yorkers know they can look forward to the return of the Ice at Canalside, a favorite activity for families and friends," said Erie Canal Harbor Development Corporation Chairperson Joan Kesner. "This year is packed with variety! 

How Do I Navigate the Social Security Maze? - Ask Rusty

Dear Rusty: I am a woman, turning 65 this October (2025). It seems that deciding when to claim Social Security is complicated. I would like more information to navigate through this maze. Thank you. Signed: Ready to Claim

Dear Ready: Deciding when to claim Social Security can be challenging, but we hope to make it a bit easier for you. You can, of course, call us at any time to speak to one of our certified Social Security Advisors, but I'll share some pertinent information here as well.

Be aware that at age 65, you have not yet reached your Social Security (SS) full retirement age (FRA). Born in 1960,

your FRA is age 67, and that is when you can get 100% of the SS benefit you've earned from a lifetime of working. If you claim SS at age 65, your monthly amount will be reduced by about 13.3% from your age 67 entitlement (a permanent reduction). If you wait a bit more and claim at age 66 the reduction would be about 6.7%. To get 100% of your "primary insurance amount" you should wait until age 67 to claim. Note you can also wait longer than your FRA and earn Delayed Retirement Credits up to age 70, when your monthly amount would be about 24% more than your FRA entitlement.

If you are still work-

ing, at age 65 you will also be subject to Social Security's Annual Earnings Test (AET) which limits how much you can earn when collecting SS benefits before your full retirement age. The earnings limit for 2025 is \$23,400 (changes annually) and if you earn more than that, SS will take away \$1 in benefits for every \$2 you are over the limit. There is also a special rule for the first calendar year you are collecting early benefits, which will result in you not getting benefits for any month your work earnings are more than \$1950 after your early benefits start. So, if you claim SS at age 65 and continue to work, you won't get any SS benefits in any 2025 month thereafter that you earn more than the monthly limit (unless your total annual; 2025 earnings are less than the annual limit). FYI, the earnings limit no longer applies once you attain your full

retirement age. In the end, deciding when you should claim Social Security should consider your need for Social Security money, your life expectancy, your plans for working, and your marital status. If you are (or were) married, you might be eligible for a spousal (or exspouse) benefit. You may also want to peruse the Social Security Q&A section at our website www. SocialSecurityReport. org. So, as you have already discerned, deciding when to claim Social Security can be confusing,

but we are always here to assist you as needed. You can either call us directly at 1.888.750.2622 or email your specific Social Security questions to us at SSAdvisor@amacfoundation.org. In either case, we will be most happy to help you decide when to claim, based on your unique personal circumstances.
