

'Grudge Match'

Speaking of vendettas, evidently the people who made the movie "Grudge Match" had been on the outs since concept. Like, not speaking to each other, particularly during filming and editing.

Rocket Man generally tries to avoid movies which won't appeal to him, but even with that caveat, many a round has been fought since the last time he saw one this bad.

The idea is that two old prizefighters, well past whatever prime they may have once had, get talked into going at it again. Think "Sunshine Boys" with boxing gloves, and without the laughs.

Robert DeNiro and Sylvester Stallone play the combatants (Rocket Man won't demean the onetime sweet science by calling them boxers.) There's some irony in the casting, as DeNiro's "Raging Bull" set the gold standard for fight films, many believe,

and Stallone, of course, founded $_{
m the}$ fantasy "Rocky" franchise. In fact, the old meat-locker scene from the original "Rocky" gets repackaged here.

In trying to promote the fight, the antagonists stumble at every turn, insulting casino sponsors and mangling the national anthem. Nonetheless, the fight, without a shred of credibility, takes off.

The actors themselves, DeNiro and Stallone, may or may not like each other, but the movie itself has absolutely no anti-chemistry. It's not as if they're old buddies, but it's easier to spell antagonism than it is to find it in their fight promos.

Kim Basinger's in. Rocket Man was stunned to find out she's 60 years old; he didn't look that healthy when he was 20. She adds a certain style, as does trainer Alan Arkin in riffing on Burgess Meredith's old take in the original

"Rocky," but when she and Stallone converse, Rocket Man had to look away. The scenery behind her keeps shifting. It has all the continuity of an acid trip.

Pittsburgh backdrops seem to practically scream "computer graphics" and then there's the matter of promoter Kevin Hart, a high flyer in one scene, rock bottom in the next. It's as if they inserted scenes from two different movies.

Rocket Man and First Mate did this as a duty tour, accompanying the newest Little Booster with nothing else available during a holiday afternoon lull. The lad, for what it's worth, said he loved it, and he sure learned a few new words, or at least heard words from the school bus now mouthed by adults who should be old enough to have his respect.

Often Rocket Man will scan some Golden Oldie and mouth, "they don't make 'em like that any more." And if they don't make 'em like "Grudge Match" any more, there's a mercy. FOUR ROCKETS (out of 10).






