Buffalo...the Dyngus Day Capital of the World

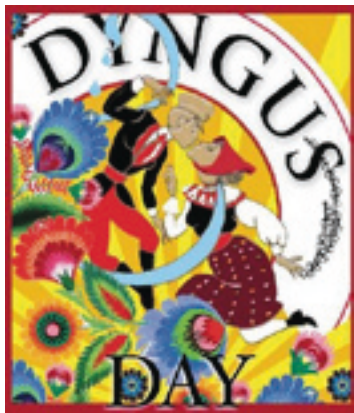

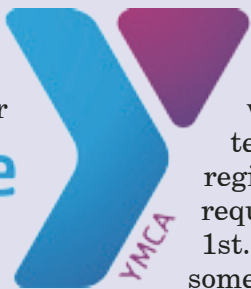
