



Okposo Helps Rescue Sabres Season

The Buffalo Sabres looked lost with only one win in six games to start the season. The crushing blow was losing a 3-0 lead on the road in Philadelphia Tuesday Oct 25 th . Their late third period collapse, surrendering two power play goals in the final three minutes of the third period, led to a 4-3 shootout loss.

That nature of that defeat seemed to suck the confidence from the Sabres. Their next game Thursday Oct. 27th was a listless 4-0 home loss to Minnesota, leaving the team with a 1-3- 2 record for 29 th place out of 30 teams. With two weekend games against strong Florida at home and at Winnipeg, the Sabres needed victories desperately to avoid falling into a 1-5- 2 hole, the type of early season record from which teams typically do not recover.

The Sabres regrouped and found their way back from impending disaster with intelligent team play and won both games, 3-0 over Florida and 3-1 at Winnipeg. This gave the team a respectable 3-3- 2 record without their injured players Jack Eichel and Evander Kane. Kyle Okposo scored half of his teams goals in the two games with one against the Panthers and two against the Jets.

Okposo has been the Sabres best player so far

this season. With seven points in seven games, he is the teams only point per game player. While Ryan O'Reilly and Rasmus Ristolainen each have seven points in eight games, they are both -2 while Okposo is a +2.

Okposo addition gives the Sabres a legitimate first line scoring winger with high end skills who is responsible defensively. Most of Okposo's goals are scored crashing the net with the puck and fighting through checks making his style ideal for the modern game of suffocating defenses. He had scored 184 points in 201 games over the previous three seasons for a 0.88 PPG average, the 17 th highest total in the league over that time. His Sabres career so far continues his success.
