Sabres Mid-Season Report

With three straight overtime victories, the Sabres are now tied with five teams at the bottom of the Eastern Conference (Carolina, Tampa Bay, Islanders, Detroit and New Jersey) and the Sabres have as many as two games in hand over some of these teams. That's what counts as progress in Sabres-land this season.

Certainly the injury which caused Jack Eichel to miss 21 games to start the season was a setback. Without Jack, the Sabres had 19 points in 21 games or .90 PPG. They scored 39 goals or 1.86 goals per game (GPG) and allowed 53 goals for 2.52 GAPG. Their goal differential -14 was the worst in the league.

Since Eichel's return, the team has improved its winning percentage and scoring with 30 points in 26 games (up 28%) for 1.15 PPG while scoring 76 goals for 2.92 GPG (up 57%). Defensively the trend has been downward with 79 goals against for 3.04

GAPG (down 21%).

Eichel's 21 points in 26 games projects to 66 points on the season. This is hardly superstar territory but the stats are somewhat misleading. He has made a big impact in several games most recently the OT game winning goal Tuesday January 24th at Nashville. And Eichel's presence in the lineup means that opponents must assign their top defenders to play against him. As a result, Ryan O'Reilly drops down to the second line and plays against lesser players. Evander Kane has been on the third line and so on.

The Sabres 1.15 PPG with Eichel projects to 54 points prorated over the full 49 games which would tie them with Boston for the last playoff spot in the division. This pure fantasy folks, I'm just looking for a ray of sunshine in the doom and gloom atmosphere of sports reporting in Buffalo.

Injuries are part of pro sports and the NHL is not going to award the Sabres sympathy points for theirs. And the Sabres "glorious" six way tie for last place could all come undone with a few consecutive losses as has been the trend.

Perhaps these incremental signs of improvement give some cause for cautious optimism today that the rebuild is heading in the right direction. We'll see if the winning ways continue Thursday at Dallas. Otherwise, who are the top prospects for the draft?
