College To Host Eclipse View and Do Event

On Monday, August 21st from 12:30 pm until 4 pm, Buffalo State College will host an Eclipse View and Do event on campus to safely view the eclipse and take part in activities for all ages. Telescopes with solar filters will be provided and free eclipse glasses will be handed out. There will be Astronomy activities and food trucks present too.

To see a total eclipse, you would have to travel to the path of totality. The path for this year’s Eclipse runs from Oregon to South Carolina. Some hotels along this path have been booked for years in anticipation of the Great American Eclipse. Like the majority of the United States, Buffalo will experience a partial eclipse. From our vantage point, about three quarters of the sun’s disk will be blackened out by the moon. Even with the moon’s partial coverage, all solar eclipses need to be viewed safely so you do not damage your eyes.

This event is free and open to the public. Attendees may park in the R-14 Lot on Rockwell Road near Grant Street.

Tonawanda's Forgotten NFL Team

With Buffalo Bills training camp underway, enthusiasm is building for the coming season. Fans of a certain age associate the Bills as a former AFL franchise founded in 1960 who joined the NFL in the 1970 AFL-NFL merger. Those same people look at you like you have three eyes if you tell them the Buffalo Bills played from 1947-49 in the All America Football Conference with the Baltimore Colts, Cleveland Browns and San Francisco 49'ers. Even more obscure is Tonawanda's forgotten NFL team, the Kardex.

There had been a history of professional football in the City of Tonawanda as far back as 1913. In 1916 and 1917 the team was known as the Tonawanda All Stars. The name became the Tonawanda Lumberjacks for 1918 and 1919. In 1920 the Tonawanda Kardex, named after their sponsor American Kardex, a North Tonawanda furniture company, had a 9-1 record playing against independent teams and two APFA teams (the predecessor of the NFL). They played their home games at Tonawanda High School and drew up to 3,500 fans at games. They were dominant allowing 6 points or fewer in all of their victories, their only loss being to their neighbors, 35-0 to the Buffalo Bisons.

Tonawanda joined the NFL for the 1921 season and

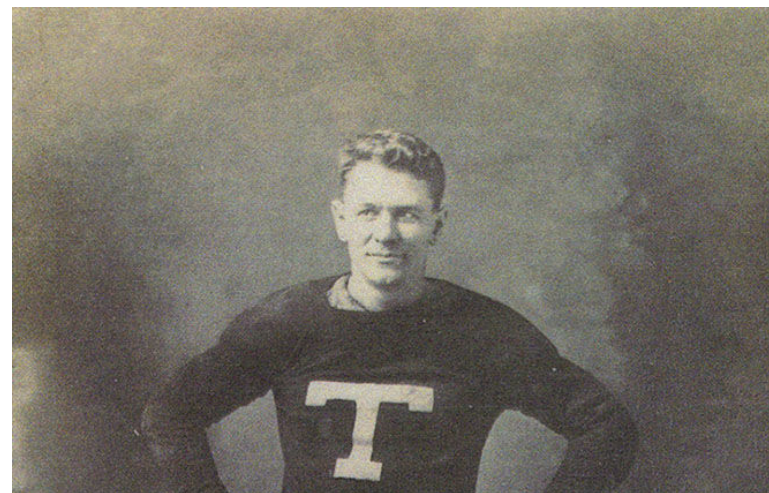
planned to play as a touring team with all road games. They wanted to play in the bigger cities with bigger crowds so they could make more money. The league was then know as the APFA for American Professional Football Association and changed it's name to the National Football League the next season in 1922. Tonawanda began the season with a 0-0 tie against the independent Syracuse Pros and a 9-7 victory over another independent team the Cleveland Panthers. Then they played their first league game and were throttled by the Rochester Jeffersons 45-0.

Tonawanda had beaten Rochester twice and Syracuse once rather easily the previous season so these disappointing results forced the team to accept that they were now unable to compete at the top level and the franchise folded. Evidence

shows the team was having a hard time scheduling opponents. The NFL raised its franchise fee from \$50 to \$1,000 for 1922 making it difficult for Tonawanda to continue. Ironically the Buffalo football Bisons finished tied for the league lead and lost a claim to the league title when the commissioner ruled them as the 3rd place team. Buffalo sports teams were getting the shaft even back then.

The Tonawanda Kardex with an 0-1 record had the shortest history of any NFL team. Two players went on to longer NFL careers including Tam Rose who later taught physical education at Tonawanda High School. There is a file of old news clippings at the Tonawanda Historical Society. There are no team photos or pictures of what the uniforms looked like. That didn't stop NFL properties from filed a trademark application for the Kardex name in 1990, reserving the right to make apparel including jerseys.

Most NFL teams from that 1921 season didn't last much longer than the Kardex. Only the Chicago Bears, Green Bay Packers and Arizona Cardinals survive today.
