Playing against the defending Champ Bulldogs from last year led by Leah Szymanski, the Purple Eagles returned to the Championship game and got revenge on last year's winner. With just a handful of girls returning to the team this year, the Eagles got tremendous hitting from their whole team at the plate all season long to capture their first house Championship

"It was just a group effort," said the quiet Zybala this past weekend, when speaking about

the game. "We just got contributions up and down the line-up both at the plate and on the diamond. Everyone hit the ball, knocking in runs to secure the win. It was a total team effort."


With Veasley and Zybala, Makenzie Kirkwood, Armani Robinson and Calianna Wild leading the way, the Purple Eagles dominated the Triple ĂAA Division all season long with an undefeated 9-0 record through May and June. Against seven other teams, like the Crimson Tide, Gators, Orange, Spartans, Volunteers, Yellow Jackets and Bulldogs, the Eagles lost just two games in the regular season in early July to claim the top cede with a 10-2 mark.

Girls like Scarlet Roman, Olivia Veasley and Mary Claire Sullivan took the mound for a string of games and controlled the defense out on the diamonds. Cicatello handled first base for the Eagles and was stellar on defense. Others like Adley Toft, Finley Shaw, Clara Siller and Phoebe Seneca had numerous hits all season and Bella Timineri-Hoover was just a spark plug for the team in confidence and spirit. All the girls worked hard to return to the Championship and win it this time.

"I had batting practice for these girls all season long," said Zybala. "The girls knew that if they weren't hitting the ball as yet, they knew to be at every practice where I could pitch to them. This was the hardest working girls I ever coached. They did it all."

Zybala should know. She and her family grew up playing Softball in Shoshone Park before getting a chance to coach Travel and House. Her older Sister Maria watched twin daughters excel on the diamonds in Shoshone. With another longtime friend, Melissa Morris, playing in the Park, Darlene found a virtual joy to be at Shoshone in those early days and be with the Morris family. "Her father was such a great guy," she said. "I miss

In the playoffs, the Purple Eagles won their first game over the expansion Orange team, 11-9. They crushed the Gators a week later in the next round before winning a hard-fought game with the Yellow Jackets, 6-4. That set up the Championship game with the Bulldogs, "I wish to thank the parents of all these beautiful girls all season," she said. "Their support is truly appreciated. My assistant coach, John Siller, was huge and my niece, Elly, kept reminding me of how this became a family thing. We are so lucky here in North Buffalo.'



Can My Wife Get Her Full Spousal Benefit at 62, or Must She Wait? - Ask Rusty

Dear Rusty: I'm 64 and my wife is 62. If my wife starts her own benefit now, she will get about \$700 on her own at 62. I will retire next year and claim Social Security when I am 65. SSA says my wife can draw \$1,100 under spousal benefits, so if she claims now, will they give her spousal benefits of \$1,100, or does she need to wait until I claim at age 65 to get the \$1,100? Signed: Trying to Understand

Dear Trying: If your wife is now 62, then her full retirement age (FRA) for Social Security purposes is age 67, and if she claims any SS benefit before reaching her FRA, the amount will be reduced for early claiming. If your wife were to claim now (before you), she would get only her own SS retirement amount

(the \$700 amount), and that would be a reduction of about 30% from what she would get if she waited until her FRA to claim.

Your wife cannot get a "spousal boost" (an additional amount as your spouse) until you claim your SS retirement benefit (at age 65?). And her benefit as your spouse at that time will also be reduced because she will not have yet reached her FRA. If your wife is already collecting her own SS retirement benefit when you later claim, she will be given her "spousal boost" to make her benefit equal what she is entitled to as your spouse. But her total monthly benefit as your spouse will also be reduced because it will be awarded before her FRA. The only way your wife can get her full spousal benefit from you is to wait until she is 67 to claim Social Security. If she claims any earlier, her monthly amount will be permanently reduced.

FYI, if you plan to claim at age 65, you should also be aware that your full retirement age (FRA) is also age 67, and claiming at age 65 will mean that you will get about 87% of the amount you would get if you waited until age 67 to claim. Again, these reductions are permanent, except for normal Cost of Living Adjustments (COLA) awarded annually thereafter.

Having said all of that, deciding when each of you should claim your Social Security benefit is a matter of financial need, while also considering your life expectancy. If your life expectancy is short and/or you need the money, then claiming early is likely the right decision. But if your life expectancy is longer and you don't urgently need the money, then you might both consider waiting longer to claim a higher monthly amount and get more in cumulative lifetime benefits.






